

2. Depower the SRS (supplemental restraint system) .

3. Detach the front seat electrical connector retainers and position the front seat wiring harnesses aside.

Torque : 62 lb.in (7 Nm)




The front seat backrest SCMG (driver multi-contour seat module) is part of the front seat power lumbar assembly and is serviced as an assembly.

1. Position the front seat to access the front seat wiring harnesses.

Note routing of the multi-contour control pump hoses for installation.

Disconnect the front seat backrest driver seat SCMG (driver multi-contour seat module)/passenger seat SCMH (passenger multi-contour seat module) hose.


- 1. Compress/squeeze the hose end fitting.
- 2. Disconnect the hose.

Torque : 62 lb.in (7 Nm)




8. Detach the front seat backrest cover lower J-clip.
