





 - 1. Pull the front center seatbelt buckle wiring harness through the front center seat frame.
 - 2. Remove the bolt.


Front Center Seatbelt Retractor - Regular Cab


Removal

NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. Insert a 1.27 mm (0.050 inch) hex key and release the front center seatbelt anchor.

Installation


NOTE

During installation, make sure the seatbelt webbing is not twisted and the seatbelts and buckles are accessible to the occupants.

- 1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 2. Check the seatbelt system for correct operation.



Removal

NOTE

Driver seat shown, passenger seat similar.

1. Remove the front seat.

- 2. Remove the seatbelt buckle.
 - 1. Detach the wiring harness retainers.
 - 2. Disconnect the electrical connector.
 - 3. Remove the bolt and the seatbelt buckle.

Torque: 30 lb.ft (40 Nm)




- 6. Disconnect the front seatbelt retractor pretensioner, load limiter and anchor pretensioner electrical connectors and position aside.
 - 1. Raise the locking tabs of the electrical connector.
 - 2. Disconnect the electrical connector.

1. Remove the front seatbelt anchor and pretensioner nut.

Torque: 30 lb.ft (40 Nm)

2. Remove the seatbelt retractor and pretensioner bolt.

Torque: 30 lb.ft (40 Nm)

Installation

WARNING

Incorrect repair techniques or actions can cause an accidental pyrotechnic device deployment. Make sure the supplemental restraint and pedestrian protection system (if equipped) is depowered before reconnecting the component. Refer to the depowering General Procedure in section 501-20B. Failure to precisely follow depowering instructions could result in serious personal injury from an accidental deployment.
