

- 2. Position the wiper motor aside to gain access to the liftgate trim panel nut.





1. Remove the spoiler (Refer to Body/Decklid/Hatch/Liftgate/Tailgate/SPOILER/Removal and Installation).




• Align the liftgate with the reference mark made previously and tighten the liftgate hinge bolts and liftgate hinge nuts to the proper specification.


# **Upper Liftgate Trim Panel**

**UPPER LIFTGATE TRIM PANEL** 




1 - Push Fasteners

- 1 Retaining Clip
- 2 Small Flat Bladed Tool
- 2. Using a small flat bladed tool, or equivalent, release the retaining clip while pulling the upper ball socket away from the ball stud.



- 1 Small Flat Bladed Tool
- 2 Retaining Clip
- 3. Using a small flat bladed tool, or equivalent, release the retaining clip while pulling the lower ball socket away from the ball stud and remove the prop from the vehicle.

- 1 Washer Hoses
- 2. Disconnect and plug the washer hoses.

3. Disconnect the wire harness connectors.

## **Spoiler - Short Wheelbase Models**

#### **SPOILER - SHORT WHEELBASE MODELS**

#### **REMOVAL**

1. Remove liftgate trim panels (Refer to Body/Decklid/Hatch/Liftgate/Tailgate/PANEL, Trim, Liftgate/Removal and Installation).



- When the spoiler is removed for repair or replacement, the gaskets at the spoiler attachment locations should be replaced.
- On vehicles equipped with Digital Rearview Mirror (DRVM): If the spoiler is replaced and the existing camera is reused, the DRVM will need to be reset. *Press and hold the plus and minus (right and left menu adjust) buttons for 15 seconds ± 5 seconds*.
