




**Torque:** M6, 10Nm Remove the screws.


**WARNING:** Be prepared to collect escaping fluid.


Special Tool: 999 7515 Puller Remove the marked part. On both sides.




Release the catch.

Use: Electrician's screwdriver




Remove the clips.
Remove the marked part.





Use: Electrician's screwdriver




Adjust to the specified value.
