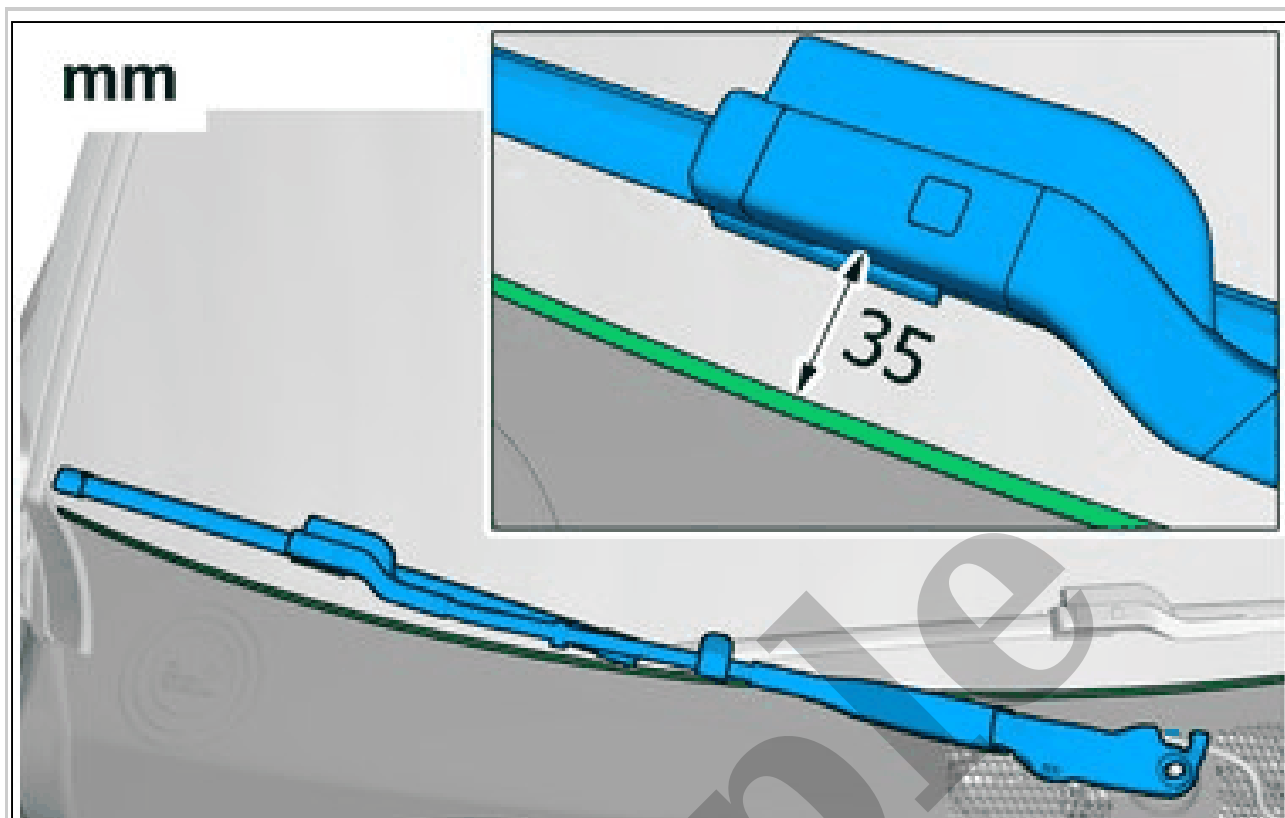

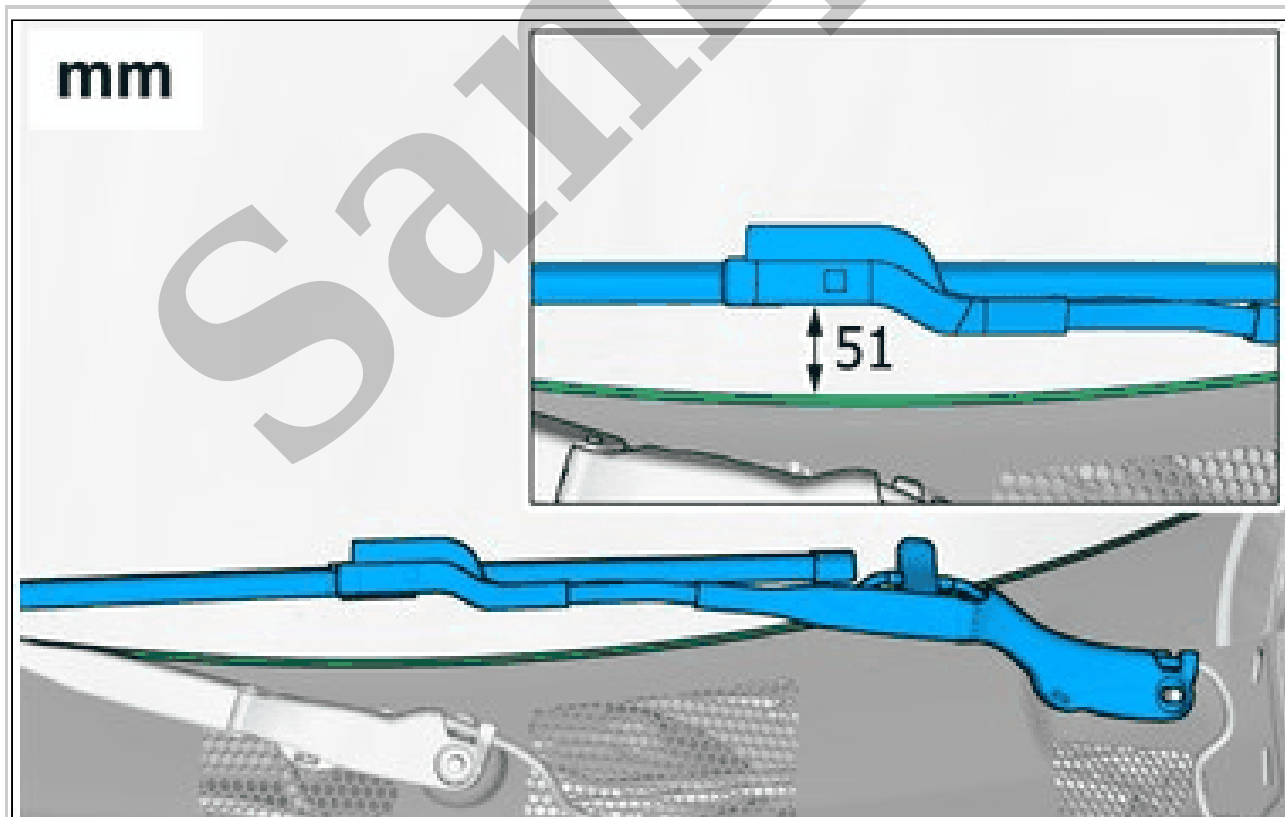
CAUTION: Note the routing of the lines and hoses.

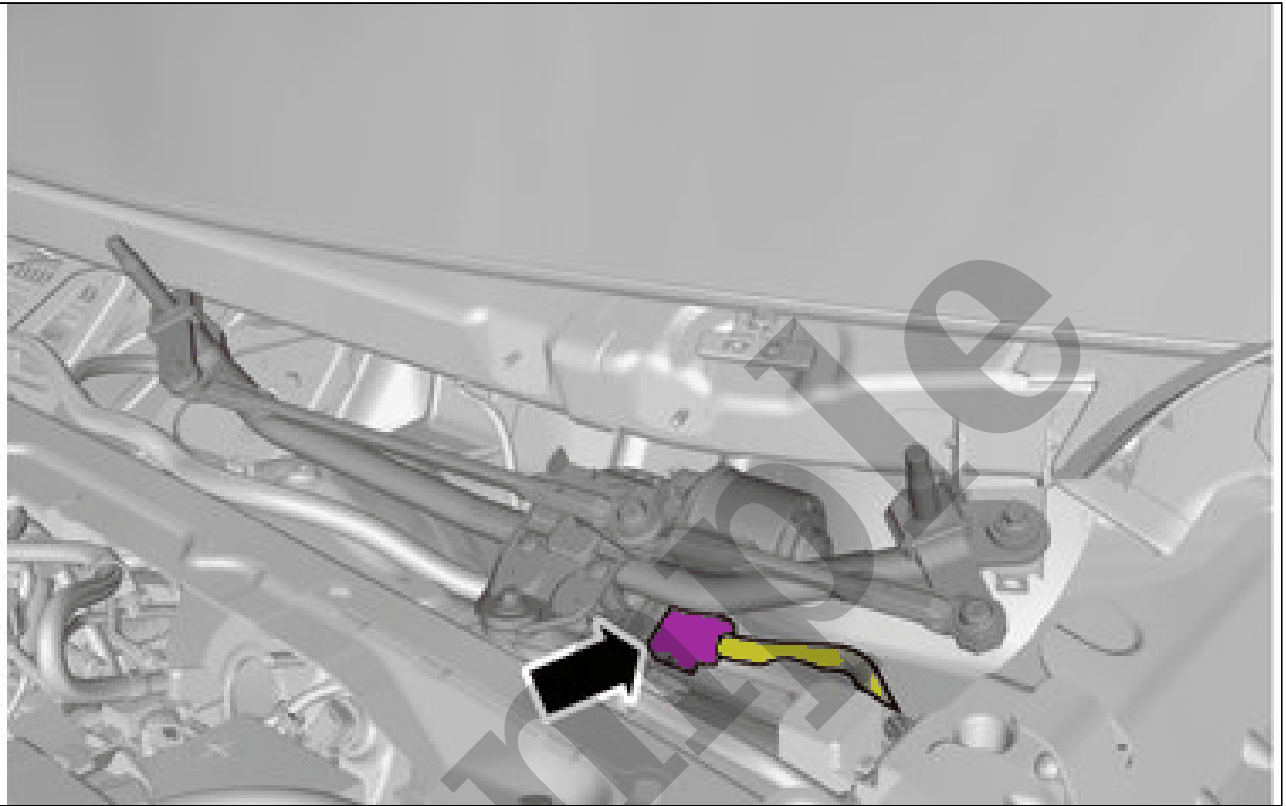

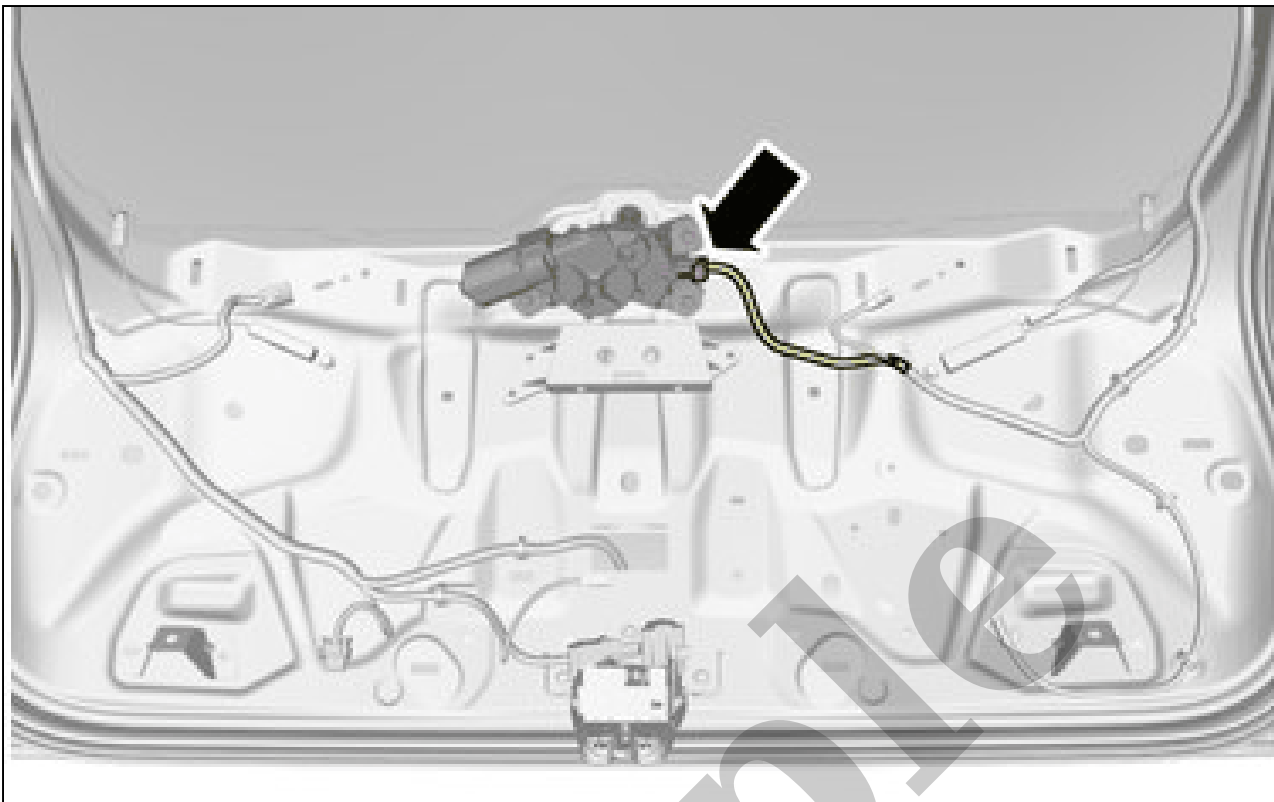

Remove the plenum cover. Refer to: PLENUM COVER



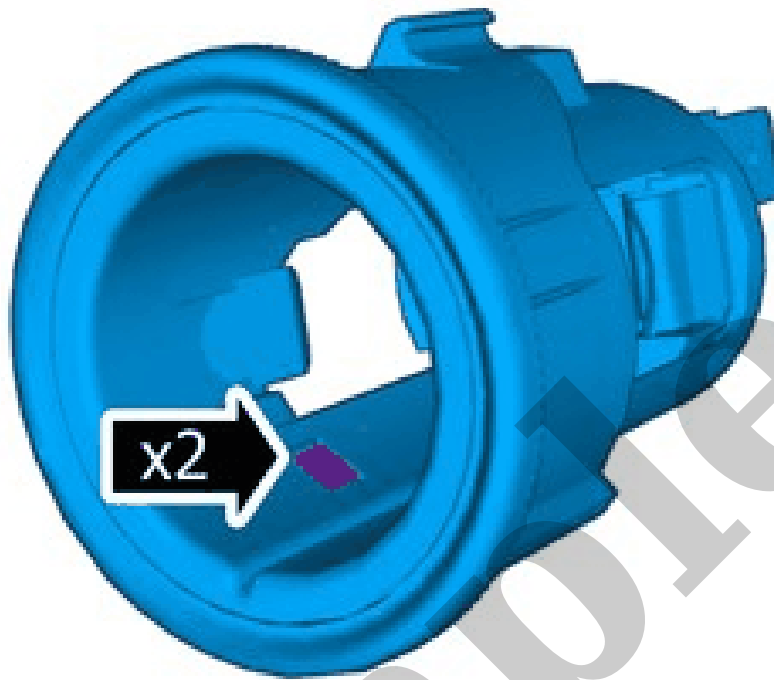

Disconnect the connector.

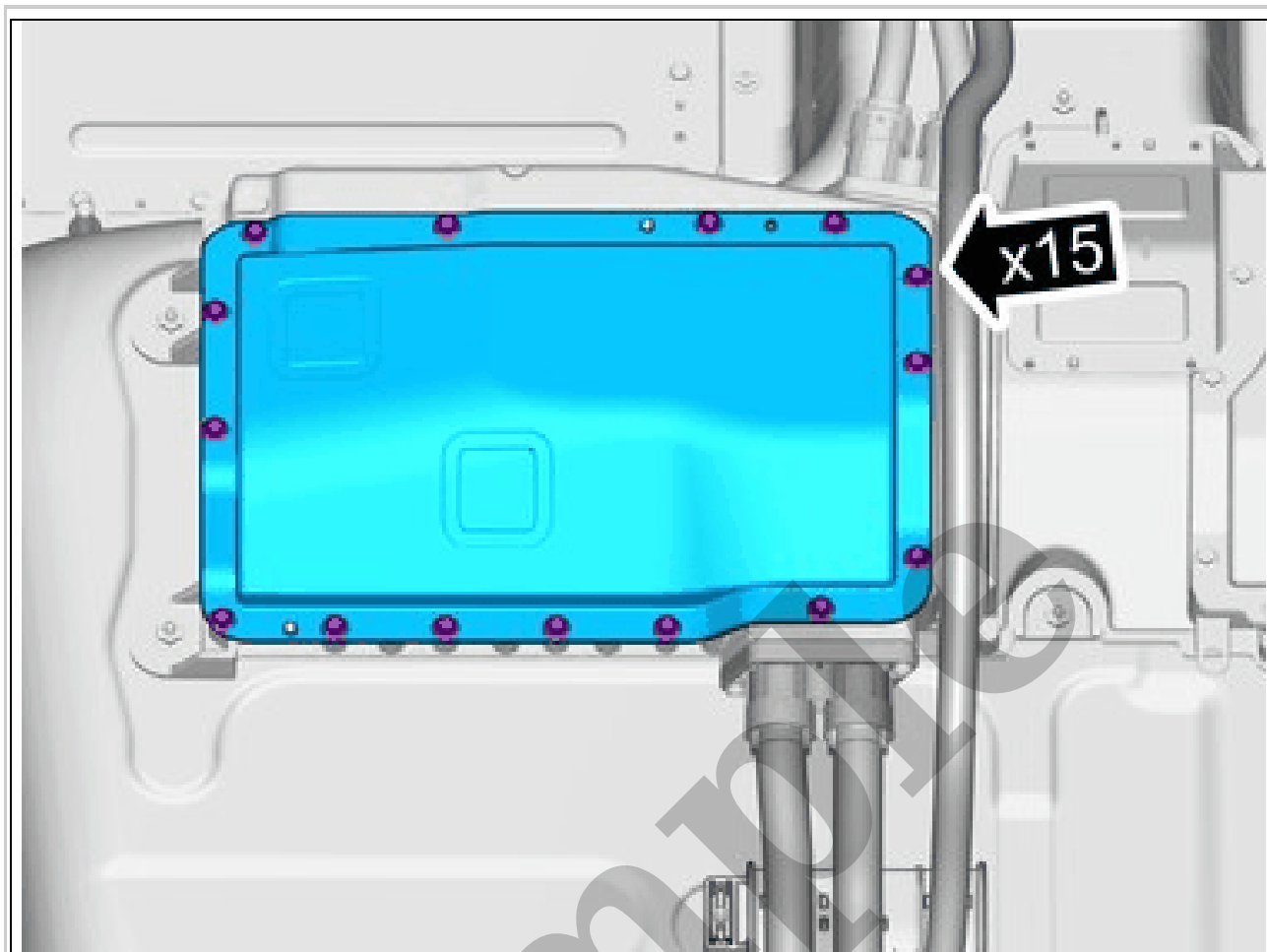

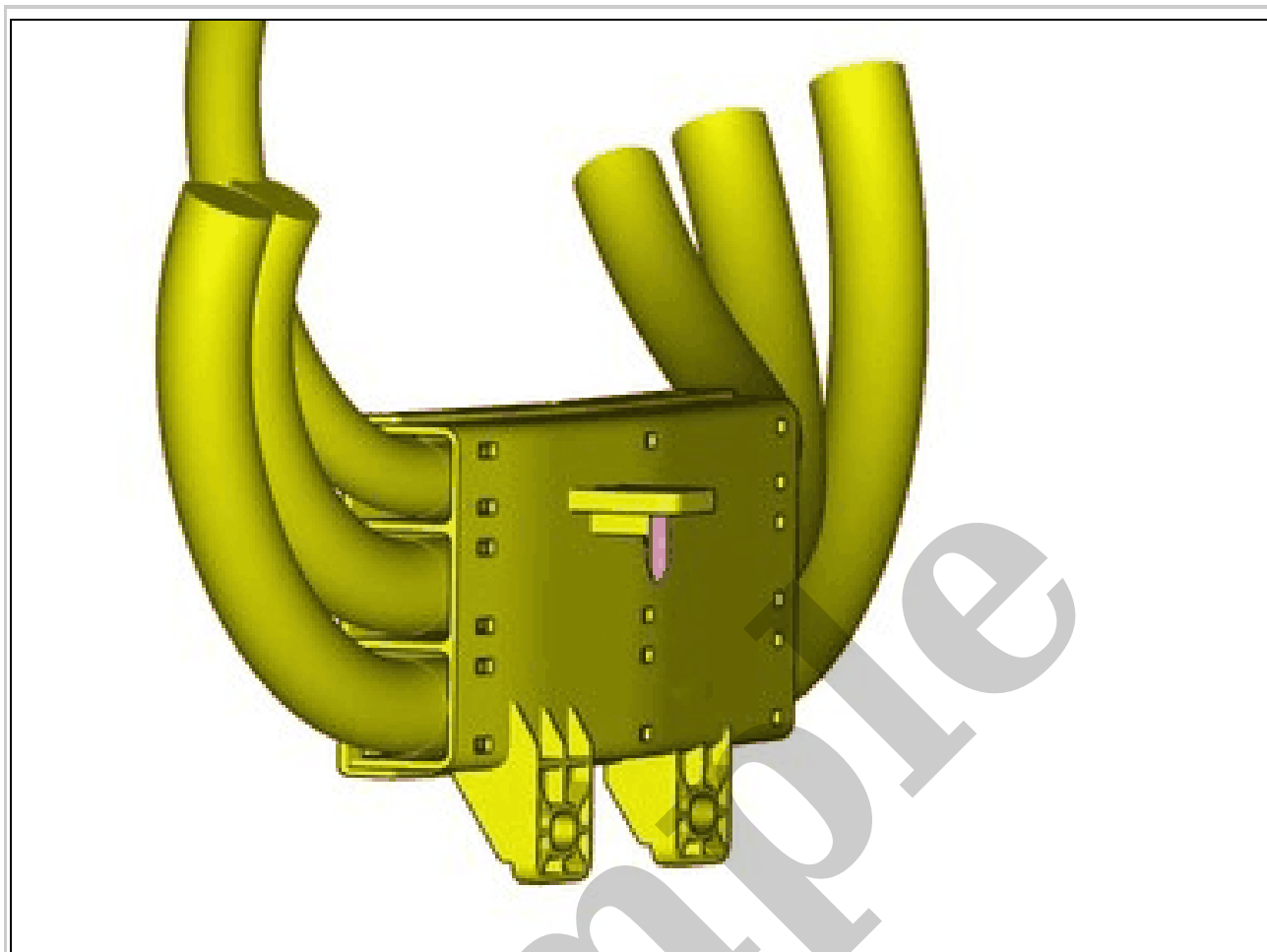

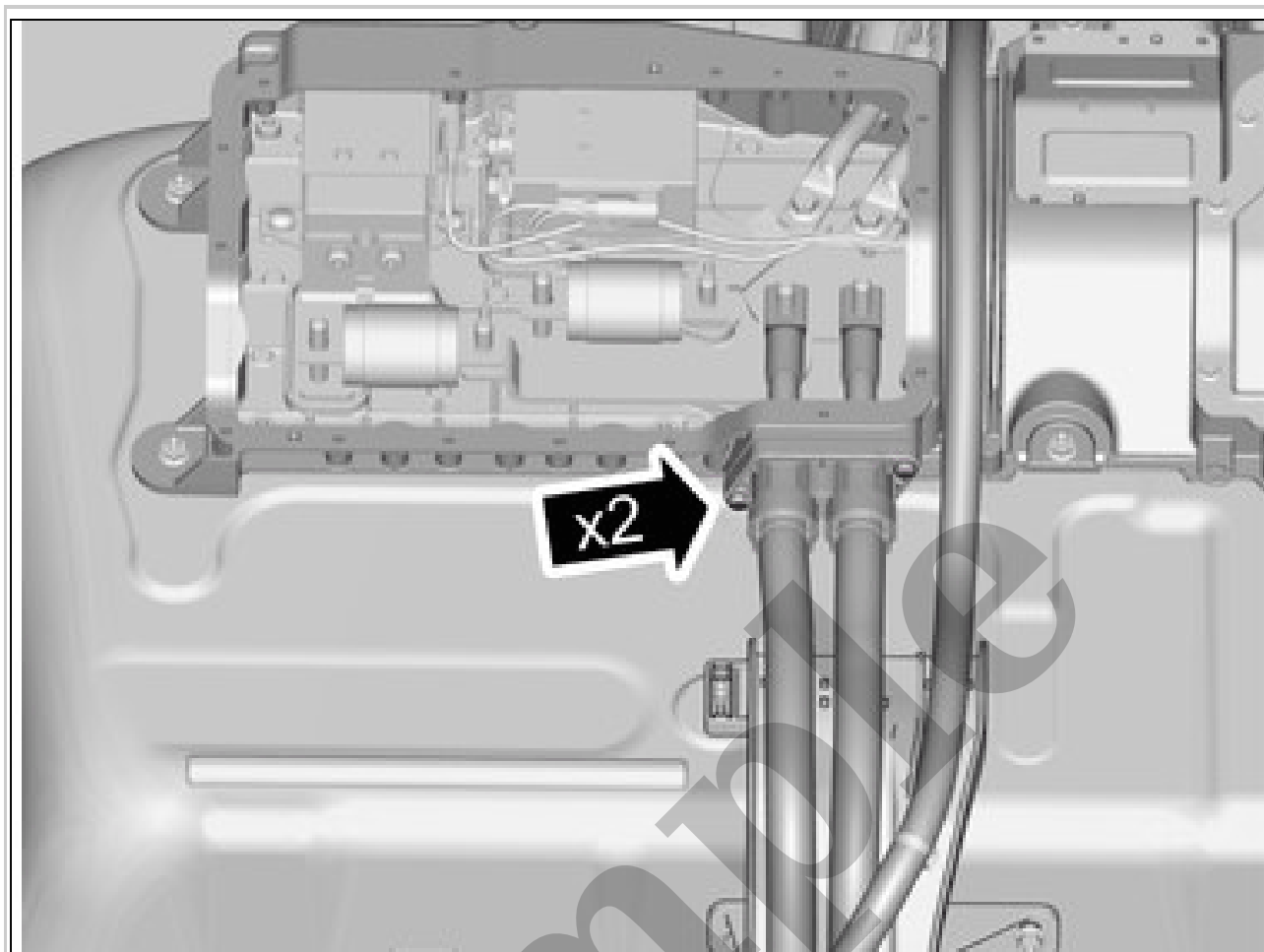
