





#### Removal

# 1. NOTE

The rear LH (left-hand) seatbelt buckle is part of the rear center seatbelt retractor and is serviced as an assembly.

Remove the rear center seatbelt retractor.


# NOTE

- 1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 2. Check the seatbelt system for correct operation.





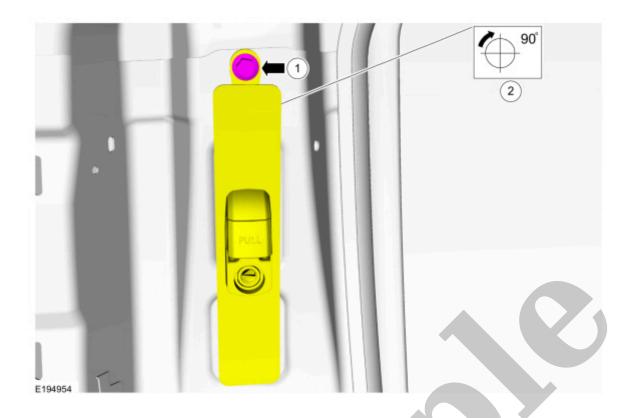
1. Remove the upper B-pillar trim panel.

# 2. NOTICE

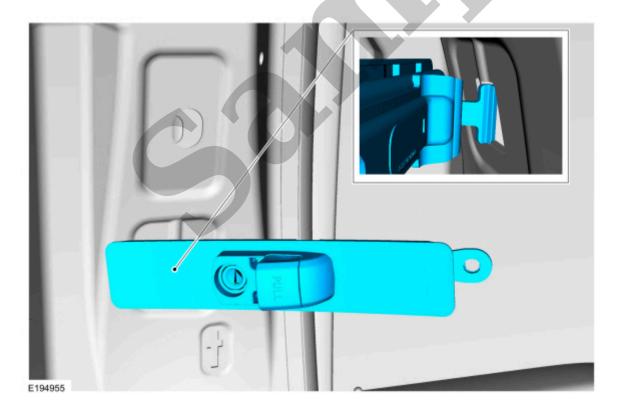
Do not use excessive force pulling the seatbelt shoulder height adjuster release latch when the front seatbelt retractor and pretensioner D-ring cover has been removed. Failure to follow this instruction may cause the release latch to be dislodged from the seatbelt shoulder height adjuster assembly.

Pull the release latch and slide the seatbelt shoulder height adjuster down.
