- 3. Apply the tape stripe or the decals that wrap into the body openings or mount on flexible surfaces wet.

 Use the following procedure for wet application of stripes and decals:
- 4. Using a 24 oz. spray bottle add 1–2 drops of unscented dishwashing soap for a wetting agent. If above 80°F you may use 2–3 drops of soap per 24 oz.
- 5. Spray a mist of solution onto the body area.
- 6. Peel the backing away from the decal.
- 7. Spray the adhesive backing of the decal in hot, humid weather with a mist of the wetting solution.
- 8. Position the decal in the desired location on the body surface.
- 9. Using a dampened squeegee, starting at the center of the decal, work from the center outward in both directions.
- 10. Squeegee the decal, in position, onto the body, removing any air bubbles along with the wetting solution.
- 11. Pull the decal back onto itself in order to remove the premask from the decal.
- 12. Squeegee the decal again.
- 13. Prick any air bubbles with a pin, if present. Never use a razor or knife as this may cause the cut to get larger over time.
- 14. If desired, heat can be applied to the edges of the stripe, decal or emblem to assure adhesion. 3 seconds at 140°F would be satisfactory.

NOTE

Important

Never use a wetting agent when installing an emblem.


Emblems should always be installed dry.

Emblem/Nameplate Replacement

Emblem/Nameplate Replacement

1. CAUTION

Caution

Refer to Exterior Trim Emblem Removal Caution.

The part and vehicle surface should be 21°C (70°F) prior to installation. The vehicle should remain inside in a temperature range of 21°C (70°F) for 1 hour after assembly to allow the adhesive to develop sufficient bond strength.

- 2. Using masking tape, mark two sides of the placement where the old emblem/nameplate was placed.
- 3. Use a heat gun or equivalent, to heat the adhesive backed emblem/nameplates.
- 4. A flat-bladed plastic tool can assist in the removal process.
- 5. Wipe the vehicle surface area with a 50/50 solution by volume of isopropyl alcohol and clean drinkable water.
- 6. Dry the area with a clean lint-free cotton cloth.
- 7. Close any doors, liftgates, endgates and rear compartment lids where emblem/nameplates are to be placed.
- 8. When removing protective liners from adhesive backed emblem/nameplates, be careful not to touch the adhesive tape or allow the tape to come in contact with dirt or any foreign matter prior to the placement and adhesion.
- 9. Remove the protective liner from the emblem/nameplate.
- 10. Position, align and press the emblem/nameplate to the previously marked location.
