



Ensure that all clips engage.

Check that the component has locked in its position.


To install, reverse the removal procedure.


**NOTE:** The following steps are only necessary when installing a new component.

Order and download the appropriate software according to: VIDA/Software/Hardware Changes



Release the locks.







Release the catch.


