Air Conditioning Fill Pipe - Electric

Removal

NOTICE

During the removal of components, cap, tape or otherwise appropriately protect all openings to prevent the ingress of dirt or other contamination. Remove protective materials prior to installation.

NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. Recover the refrigerant.

Refer to: Air Conditioning (A/C) System Recovery, Evacuation and Charging - Electric(412-00 Climate Control System - General Information, General Procedures).

2. Remove the underhood storage compartment.

Refer to: Underhood Storage Compartment - Electric(501-02 Front End Body Panels, Removal and Installation).

3. 1. Remove the compressor outlet line nut and disconnect the fitting.

Torque: 80 lb.in (9 Nm)

2. Detach the wiring harness routing clip.


Air Distribution Door Actuator

Removal

1. Remove the accelerator pedal.

2. Remove the bolt and the floor duct.


Air Inlet Door Actuator

Removal

1. Remove the instrument panel.

- 2. Remove the screws and the air inlet door actuator.
 - Disconnect the electrical connector.

Removal

NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

Vehicles With: Short Arm Mirrors

1. NOTICE

Position the screwdriver using the service slot in the mirror glass backing plate to remove the mirror glass. Prying on the backing plate in other locations may damage the mirror glass.

Remove the exterior mirror glass.

- 1. Position the mirror glass in and up.
- 2. Using a flat blade screwdriver separate the exterior mirror glass from the exterior mirror motor.

3. NOTE

The number and location of the electrical connectors will vary based on mirror option content.

Disconnect the exterior mirror glass electrical connectors.


- 3. Remove the exterior mirror bezel.
 - 1. Remove the exterior mirror bezel screws.
 - 2. Release the exterior mirror bezel tabs and release the clip with screwdriver.
 - 3. Slide the exterior mirror bezel outward off the tabs.


4. Position the mirror arm in slightly.

6. Using a suitable tool, pry and detach the ambient air temperature sensor bezel from the RH (right-hand) exterior mirror arm housing.








Vehicles equipped with TCCM (transfer case control module).
