





## Floor Console End CAP

#### FLOOR CONSOLE END CAP

- 1 Floor Console End Cap
- 5. Using a trim stick or equivalent, release the floor console end cap from the floor console.
- 6. Disconnect all of the wire harness connectors.
- 7. Remove the console end cap from the vehicle.

#### INSTALLATION

Follow the removal procedure in reverse for general reassembly of the components on the vehicle. The steps listed below are calling out specific procedures that should be followed during installation.

- Install all fasteners are tighten securely.
- Replace the front floor console armrest hinge cover with a **NEW** part.

1. Using a trim stick or equivalent, release and remove the floor console lower side trim panel.

#### INSTALLATION

Follow the removal procedure in reverse for general reassembly of the components on the vehicle. The steps listed below are calling out specific procedures that should be followed during installation.


• Hand tap to fully engage the retaining clips.

- 1 Compartment Door
- 2 Fastener
  - 2316167325 1 - Overhead Console 2 - Wire Harness Connector
  - 1. Open the compartment door in the overhead console and remove the fasteners.

2. Using a trim stick or equivalent, open a gap large enough to grasp both of the sides of the overhead console and disengage the retaining clips.



- 1 Blackplate
- 2 Retaining Tabs
- 3 Main Bezel
- 3. Disengage the retaining tabs from around the perimeter of the overhead console and carefully separate the main bezel from the backplate.



1 - Cup Holder Assembly

3. Using a trim stick or equivalent, release the cup holder assembly from the floor console and lift up to remove.

#### INSTALLATION

Follow the removal procedure in reverse for general reassembly of the components on the vehicle. The steps listed below are calling out specific procedures that should be followed during installation.

• Press firmly to fully engage the cup holder retaining tabs into the floor console.

### Headliner

#### HEADLINER

#### REMOVAL

#### CAUTION

Hands should be clean or clean cloth gloves used when handling the headliner to avoid damage to the headliner.

- 1. Disconnect and isolate the negative battery cable(s) (Refer to Electrical/Battery System/Standard Procedure).
- 2. Remove the right front seat (Refer to Body/Seats/SEAT Front/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 1).
- 3. Position the second row seats to the down position.
- 4. If equipped, position the third row seats to the down position.
- 5. Remove the visors (Refer to Body/Interior/VISOR/Removal and Installation).
- 6. Remove the visor supports (Refer to Body/Interior/SUPPORT, Visor/Removal and Installation).
- 7. Remove the overhead console (Refer to Body/Interior/CONSOLE, Overhead/Removal and Installation).
- 8. If equipped, remove the rear interior camera (Refer to Electrical/8A Audio and Video/CAMERA, Rear Interior/Removal and Installation).
- If equipped, remove the rear view mirror upper and lower covers (Refer to Body/Interior/MIRROR, Rearview/Removal and Installation) to gain access to the rear view mirror wire harness connector(s). Disconnect the wire harness connector(s).
- 10. Remove the A-pillar trim panels (Refer to Body/Interior/PANEL, A-Pillar Trim/Removal and Installation).
- 11. Remove the upper B-pillar trim panels (Refer to Body/Interior/PANEL, B-Pillar Trim/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 2).

#### CAUTION

Hands should be clean or clean cloth gloves used when handling the headliner to avoid damage to the headliner.

• Press firmly to engage hook and loop fasteners.
