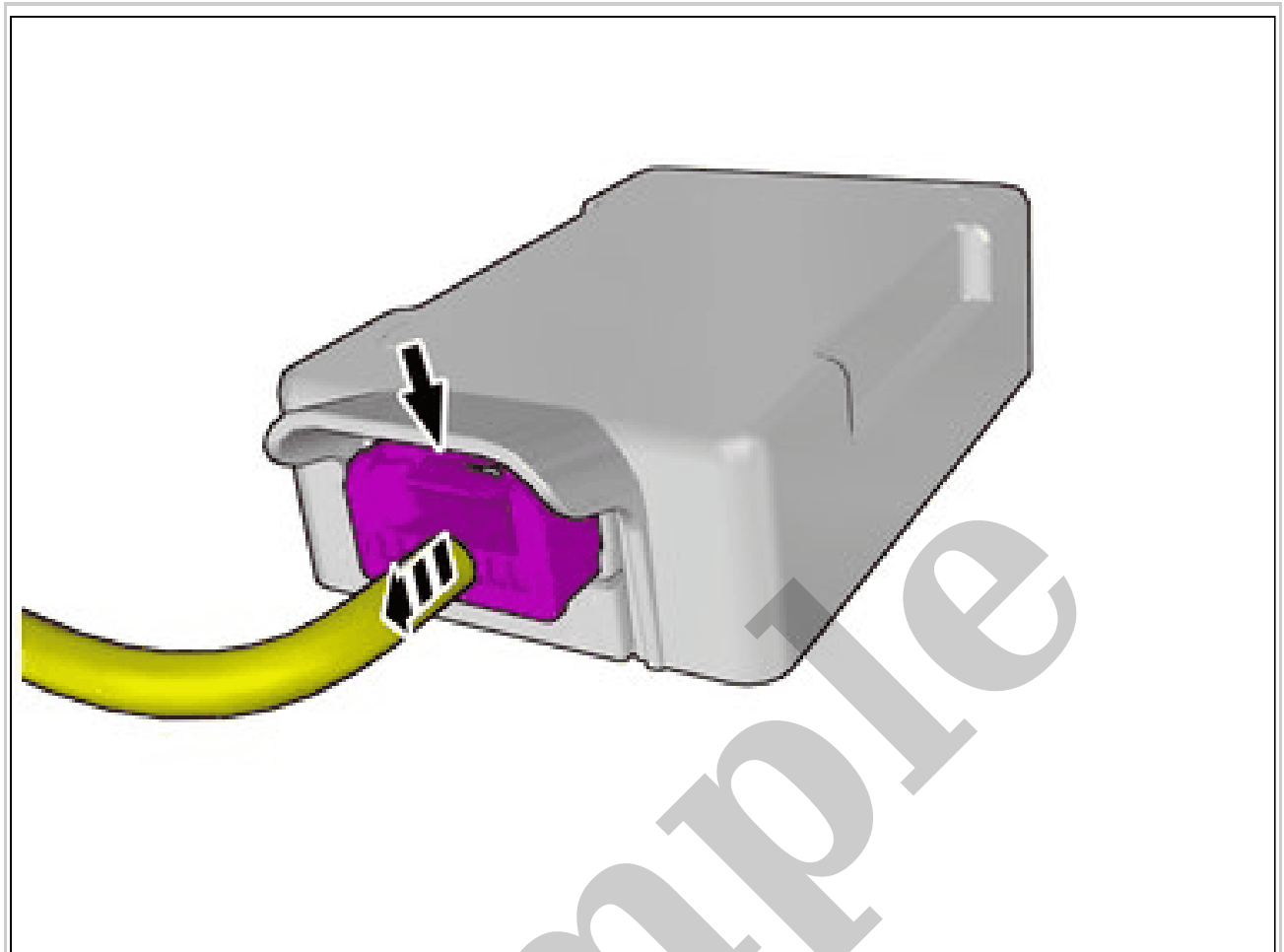

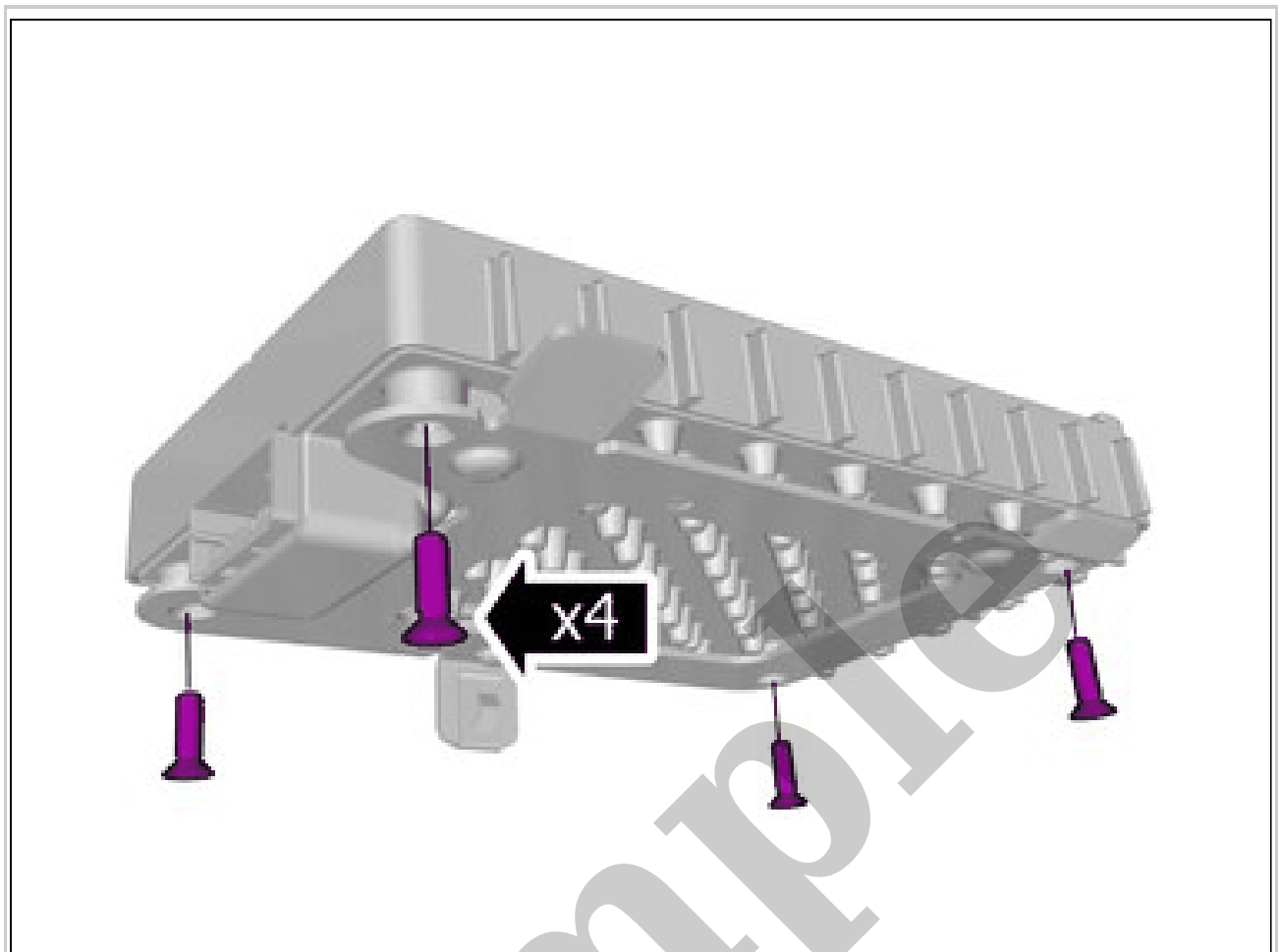
Depress the locking device.

OBD FIREWALL MODULE > OBD FIREWALL MODULE (OFM) [2018-2020] > INSTALLATION

To install, reverse the removal procedure.

WIRELESS PHONE CHARGER > WIRELESS PHONE CHARGER (WPC) [2018-2022] > REMOVAL

Set the vehicle to Inactive mode, described in user mode. Refer to: USAGE MODE

WIRELESS PHONE CHARGER > WIRELESS PHONE CHARGER (WPC) [2018-2022] > INSTALLATION

To install, reverse the removal procedure.

The Forward Looking Camera 2 (FLC2) is a high definition camera that is mounted behind the windshield, near the rear view mirror. It has a field of view that is 100° horizontal and 39.2° vertical and is used by safety related functions. The FLC2 has built-in heating to prevent the windshield from being fogged up.

The Forward Looking Camera 2 (FLC2) has a built-in diagnostic system, which continuously monitors the control module. The FLC2 sets DTCs and has readable parameters.

FORWARD LOOKING CAMERA 2 > FORWARD LOOKING CAMERA 2 (FLC2) (4/318) [2021-2022, E400V6] > CONNECTION AND COMMUNICATION

The Forward Looking Camera 2 (FLC2) is a FlexRay slave and communicates with the Active Safety Domain Master (ASDM).

FORWARD LOOKING RADAR > FORWARD LOOKING RADAR (FLR) (4/291) [2021- 2022, E400V6] > DESCRIPTION

The Forward Looking Radar (FLR) is mounted in the grill in the front of the vehicle. It identifies objects in front of the vehicle when using safety related functions. There is heating in the cover of the radar to prevent ice from building up.

The Forward Looking Radar (FLR) has a built-in diagnostic system, which continuously monitors the control module. The FLR sets DTCs and has readable parameters.

The Forward Looking Radar (FLR) is a CAN slave and communicates with the Active Safety Domain Master (ASDM).

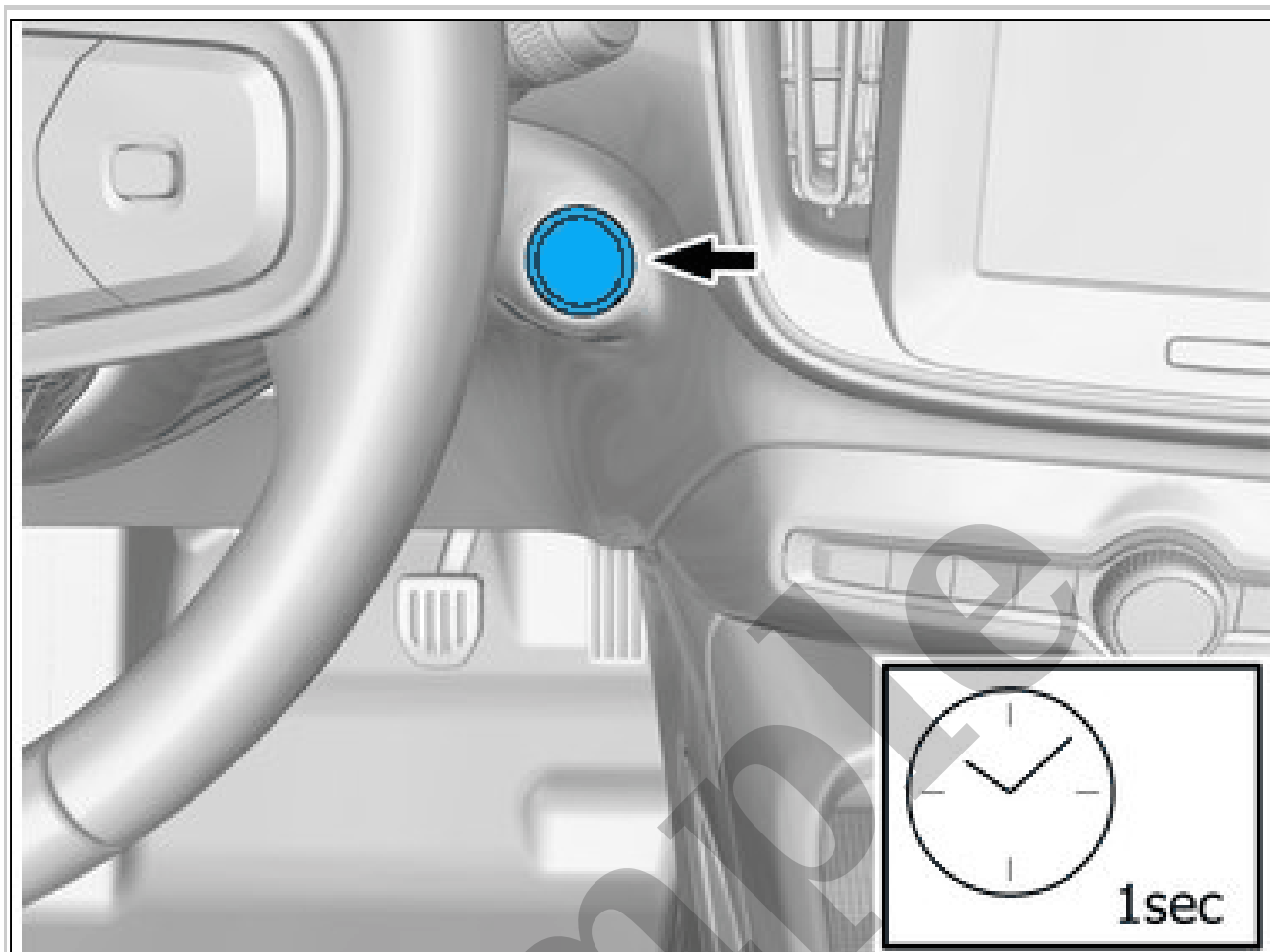
PARKING ASSISTANCE CAMERA > PARKING ASSISTANCE CAMERA (27/6 - 27/8, 27/11) [2018-2022] > DESCRIPTION

The parking assistance camera is a satellite camera that scans the vehicle surroundings and provides a Low-Voltages Differential Signal LVDS video signal output.

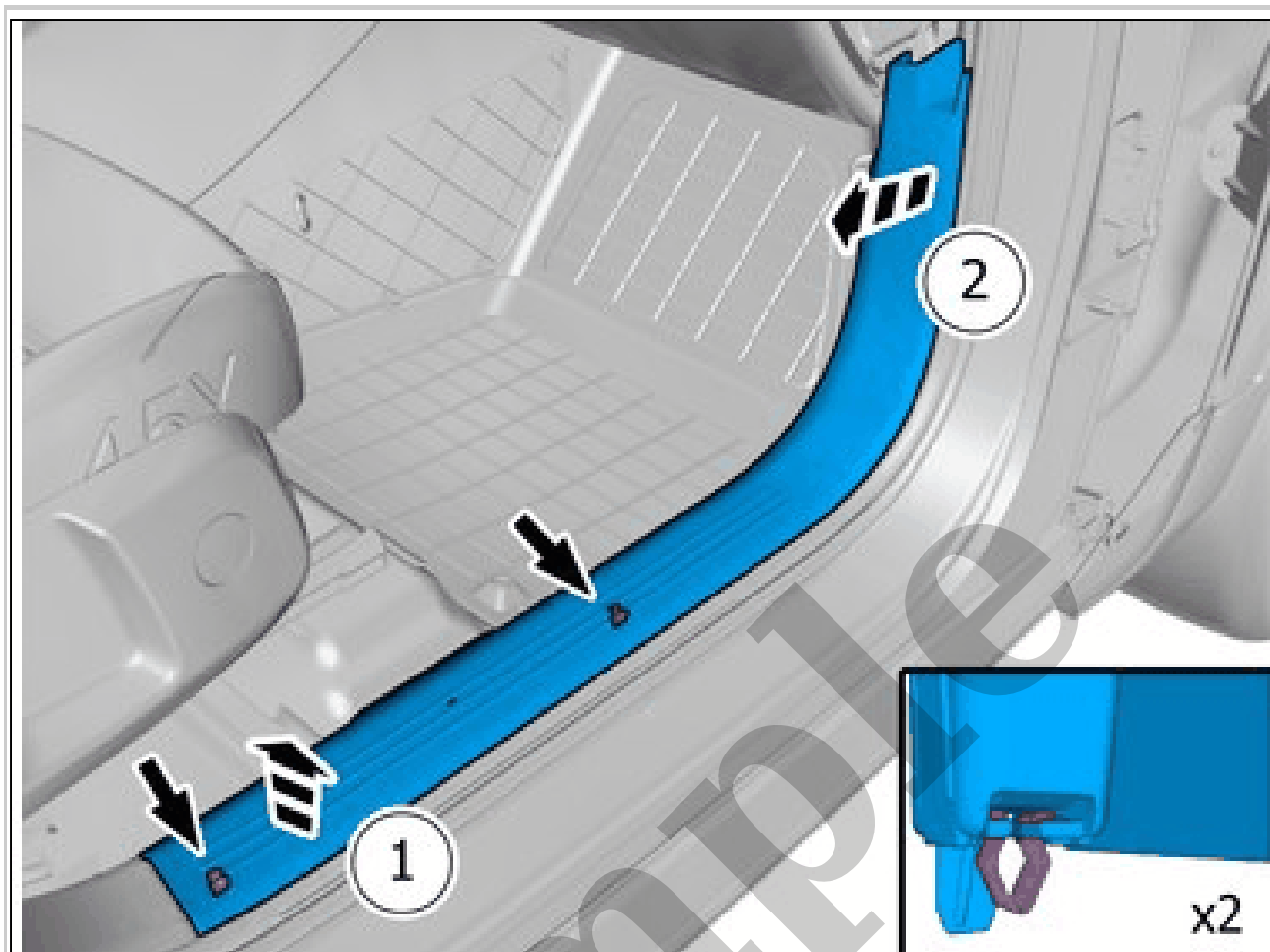

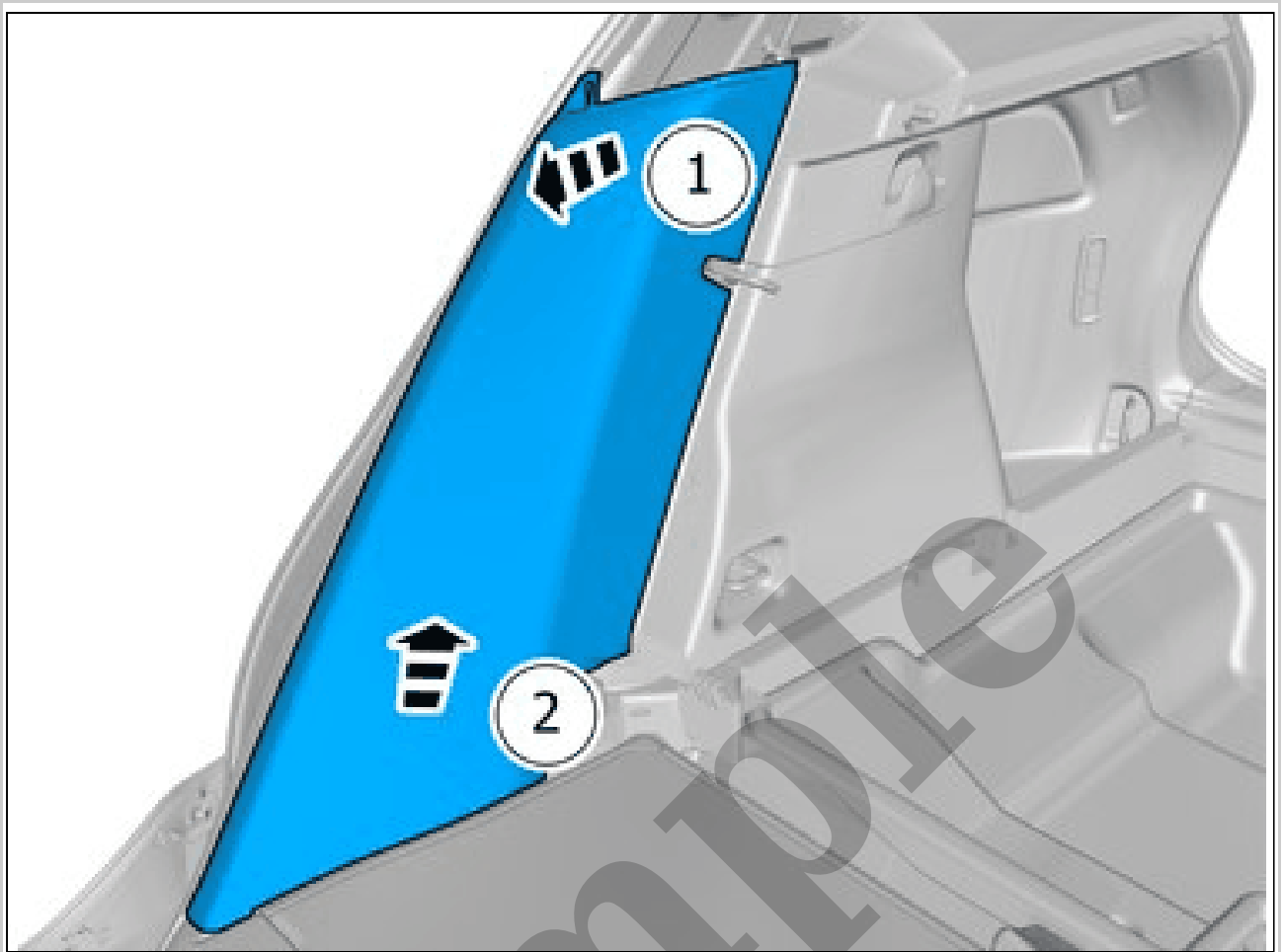
REMOVAL
