



Removal

1. Remove the climate control housing.

Removal


NOTE

If a heater core leak is suspected, the heater core must be leak tested before it is removed from the vehicle.

1. Remove the climate control housing.

2. Remove the retainers and the heater core cover.




Installation




Installation

- 1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 2. If a new HVAC (heating, ventilation and air conditioning) module has been installed, download the HVAC (heating, ventilation and air conditioning) module configuration information from the scan tool to the new HVAC (heating, ventilation and air conditioning) module by following the scan tool on-screen instructions.


4. Release the clips and remove the floor console lower LH (left-hand) trim panel.



 - Disconnect the electrical connector.



9. Release the clips and remove the LH (left-hand) center trim panel.


