

- 1 J-Straps
- 2 Lower Hidden Fasteners
- 3 J-Hooks
- 4 Lower Seat Back Panel
- 5 Retaining Tabs
- 3. Unhook the J-Straps from the flap at the bottom of the cover going to the seat frame and lift lower fabric to access lower hidden fasteners.
- 4. Remove the back panel lower hidden fasteners.
- 5. Pull the seat back panel out to release the retaining tabs, then down to release hidden J-Hooks to remove lower seat back panel.

- 1 Front Seat Track to Floor Front Bolts
- 5. Remove the front seat track to floor front bolts.
- 6. Disconnect the wire harness connectors.
- 7. Remove the seat from the vehicle.

INSTALLATION

Follow the removal procedure in reverse for general reassembly of the components on the vehicle.



Massage Seat Air Cells


MASSAGE SEAT AIR CELLS

REMOVAL

- 1. If servicing the seat back air cells, remove the seat back cover (Refer to Body/Seats/COVER, Seat Back/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 1).
- 2. If servicing the seat cushion air cells, remove the seat cushion cover (Refer to Body/Seats/COVER, Seat Cushion, Front/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 2).



- 1. Before proceeding with the following repair procedure, review all warnings and cautions (Refer to Body/Seats Warning)(Refer To List 1).
- 2. Remove the seat from the vehicle (Refer to Body/Seats/SEAT/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 2).
- 3. Remove the seat back frame (Refer to Body/Seats/FRAME, Seat Back, Front/Removal and Installation).
- 4. Remove the seat cushion cover (Refer to Body/Seats/COVER, Seat Cushion, Front/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 3).

5. Remove any transferable components from the seat track assembly.
