Removal


NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. WARNING

Always allow the engine to cool before opening the cooling system. Do not unscrew the coolant pressure relief cap when the engine is operating or the cooling system is hot. The cooling system is under pressure; steam and hot liquid can come out forcefully when the cap is loosened slightly. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious personal injury.


Release the cooling system pressure by slowly turning the pressure relief cap between 2 and 3 turns and remove the pressure relief cap.



Installation

- 1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 2. Fill and bleed the cooling system. Refer to the appropriate procedure in Group 303.


2. Remove the air cleaner outlet pipe RH (right-hand) .

3. Release the hose clamps and disconnect inlet and outlet coolant hoses.



6. Remove the bolt and the cabin heater coolant pump.

Removal

NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. Remove the RHF (right-hand front) fender splash shield.

Refer to: Fender Splash Shield(501-02 Front End Body Panels, Removal and Installation).

2. NOTE

Be prepared to collect escaping fluid.

- 1. Disconnect the electrical connector.
- 2. Clamp the coolant hoses, release the clamps and disconnect the inlet and outlet coolant hoses.

3. Remove the retainer and the cabin heater coolant pump.

Torque: 18 lb.ft (25 Nm)

1. Remove the center display screen.



2. Release the clips, separate the trim pin, and remove the RH (right-hand) instrument panel trim panel.

4. Remove the bolts and the RH (right-hand) center register.

Torque: 22 lb.in (2.5 Nm)



- 5. Release the clips, position the start/stop switch bezel aside.
 - Ddisconnect the electrical connector and remove the start/stop switch bezel.

- 7. Remove the bolts and the LH (left-hand) center register.
