

The turbocharger compressor vanes can be damaged by even the smallest particles. When removing any turbocharger or engine air intake system component, ensure that no debris enters the system. Failure to do so may result in damage to the turbocharger.

Loosen the clamp and position the air cleaner outlet pipe RH (right-hand) aside.

Torque: 44 lb.in (5 Nm)




5. Disconnect the battery positive cable.

6. Disconnect the hose.




- 8. Remove the A/C (air conditioning) compressor inlet line nut and disconnect the fitting.
 - Make sure to cover any open ports to prevent debris from entering the system.




10. Remove the radiator grille.

11. Remove the retainers and position the RH (right-hand) splash shield aside.





Installation

1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.


2. NOTICE

Only use the specified material to lubricate the seals.

Install and lubricate new O-ring seals. Refer to the appropriate Specifications in Group 412.

3. Lubricate the refrigerant system with the correct amount of clean PAG oil. Refer to the appropriate Refrigerant Oil Adding procedure in Group 412.

- 4. Remove the following items:
 - Remove the battery tray.

• Remove the A/C (air conditioning) compressor inlet line.

5. 1. Remove the A/C (air conditioning) compressor outlet line nut and disconnect the fitting.

- 2. Disconnect the A/C (air conditioning) pressure transducer electrical connector.
- 3. Remove the support bracket retainer , and remove the A/C (air conditioning) compressor outlet line.
- Make sure to cover any open ports to prevent debris from entering the system.

Removal

NOTICE

During the removal or installation of components, cap, tape or otherwise appropriately protect all openings and tubes/fittings to prevent the ingress of dirt or other contamination. Remove caps, tape and other protective materials prior to installation.

NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

- 1. Recover the refrigerant. Refer to the appropriate Recovery procedure in Group 412.
- 2. Remove the battery tray.



3. Remove the inveter system controller.

4. 1. Remove the ground wire retainer.


Torque: 80 lb.in (9 Nm)



7. Remove the radiator grille.

Installation

1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.


