

- 1 Inner Side Shield
- 2 Molded Tabs
- 3 Retaining Clips
- 3. Disengage the molded tabs and the retaining clips from the inner side shield. Pull up and outward to remove the inner side shield.

3. Remove the fasteners and lift up to remove the outer side shield from the seat frame.

These fasteners have special coatings and are specifically designed for the SRS. Anytime a new fastener is needed, replace it with the correct fasteners provided in the service package or specified in the Mopar® Parts Catalog.

# **WARNING**

To avoid serious or fatal injury when a steering column has an airbag unit attached, never place the column on the floor or any other surface with the steering wheel or airbag unit face down. Failure to follow these instructions may result in possible serious or fatal injury.



# **REMOVAL**

1. Remove the seat from the vehicle (Refer to Body/Seats/SEAT/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 1).



Follow the removal procedure in reverse for general reassembly of the components on the vehicle. The steps listed below are calling out specific procedures that should be followed during installation.

• If the seat back cover was separated from the seat back foam, the use of **NEW** hog ring will be required for installation.


# THIRD ROW SEAT BACK FRAME

# **REMOVAL**

1. Remove the seat from the vehicle (Refer to Body/Seats/SEAT/Removal and Installation)(Refer To List 1).

# **NOTE**

Power seat must remain in the upright / locked position while servicing the seat.



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1 - Marriage Bracket Bolts

- 23 Body / Seats, Second Row / SIDE SHIELDS / Removal and Installation
- 23 Body / Seats, Third Row / SIDE SHIELDS / Removal and Installation



- 23 Body / Seats, Second Row / SEAT, Second Row / Removal and Installation
- 23 Body / Seats, Third Row / SEAT, Third Row / Removal and Installation
