





 - Disconnect the electrical connector.


Use the General Equipment: Interior Trim Remover






- 6. Remove the bolts and the FCIM (front controls interface module) .
 - Disconnect the electrical connectors.

Torque: 22 lb.in (2.5 Nm)






9. **NOTE**

Remove the rubber pad.

Torque: 55 lb.in (6.2 Nm)





The push pin must be replaced each time the bezel is removed.


Release the retainers and remove the LH (left-hand) register bezel.


• Remove and discard the push pin.



- 14. Remove the bolts and the display unit.
 - Disconnect the electrical connectors.

Torque: 55 lb.in (6.2 Nm)

17. **NOTE**


Do not reuse push pins.

Remove the push pins, release the clips and remove the trim panel.

Vehicles with storage compartment

19. Remove the bolts, release the clips and remove the upper storage compartment.

Torque: 22 lb.in (2.5 Nm)



20. Remove the screws through the upper stowage bin opening.


22. Disconnect the passenger airbag electrical connector.

Instrument Panel

Removal

NOTE

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. Depower the SRS (supplemental restraint system).

2. Remove the floor console.

Refer to: Floor Console(501-12 Instrument Panel and Console, Removal and Installation).

3. Remove both A-pillar trim panels.

Refer to: A-Pillar Trim Panel (501-05 Interior Trim and Ornamentation, Removal and Installation).

4. Release the clips and remove the LH (left-hand) instrument panel trim panel.
