



## **Brake Pressure Modulator Valve Replacement**


### **Removal Procedure**

- 1. Place the ignition in the OFF position.
- 2. Remove the air cleaner outlet duct. Air Cleaner Outlet Duct Replacement
- 3. Thoroughly clean the area surrounding the electronic brake control module (EBCM) to brake pressure modulator valve (BPMV) of any accumulated dirt and debris.
- 4. Disconnect the EBCM electrical connector.

  Disconnect the left front brake pipe fitting nut (1).
- 10. Cap the brake pipe and plug the BPMV outlet port to prevent brake fluid loss and contamination.
- 11. Disconnect the right front brake pipe fitting nut (2).
- 12. Cap the brake pipe and plug the BPMV outlet port to prevent brake fluid loss and contamination.

# NOTE

## Note

It is not necessary to remove the BPMV assembly nuts.

Loosen the 2 BPMV assembly nuts (1).
