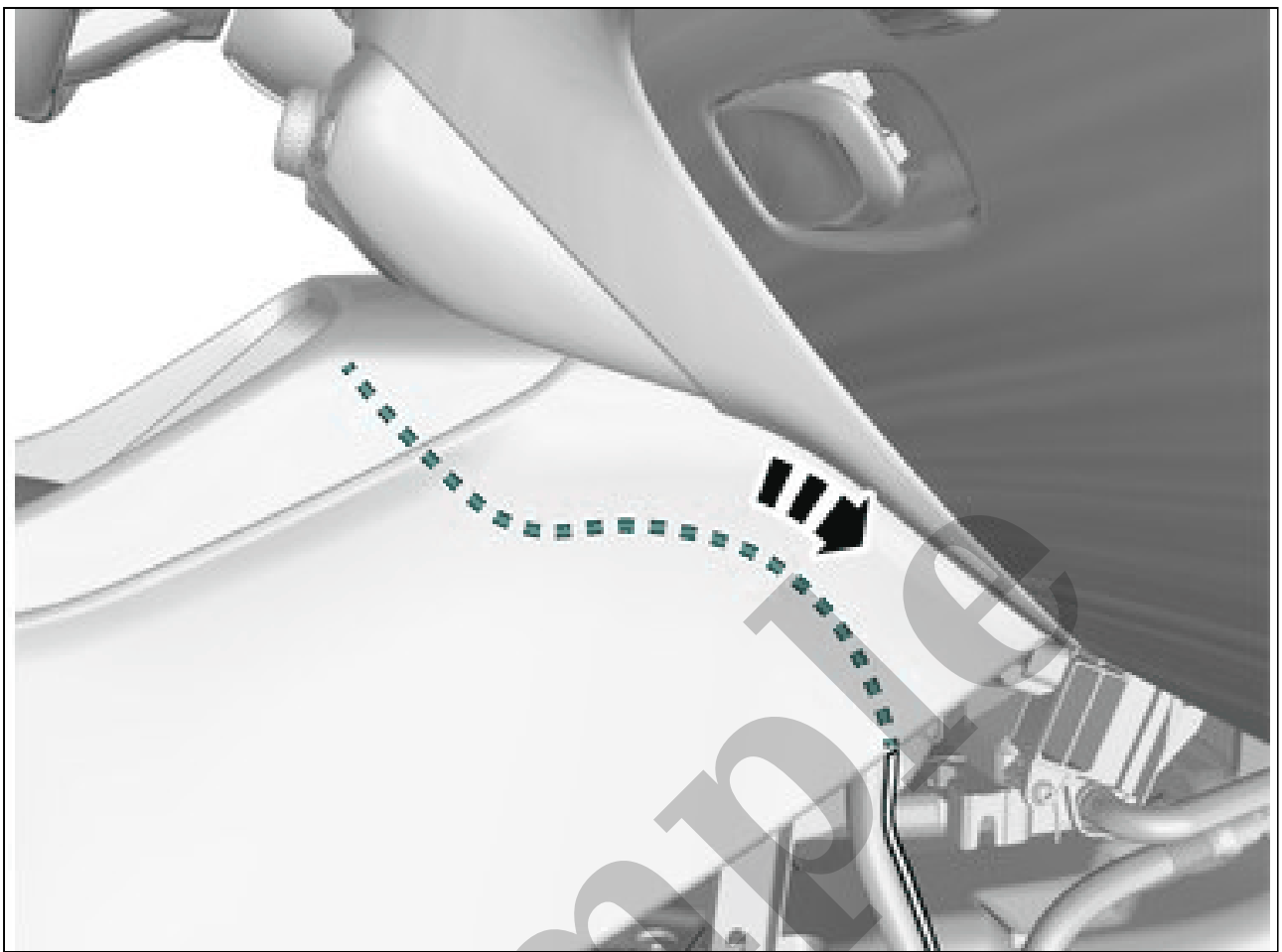

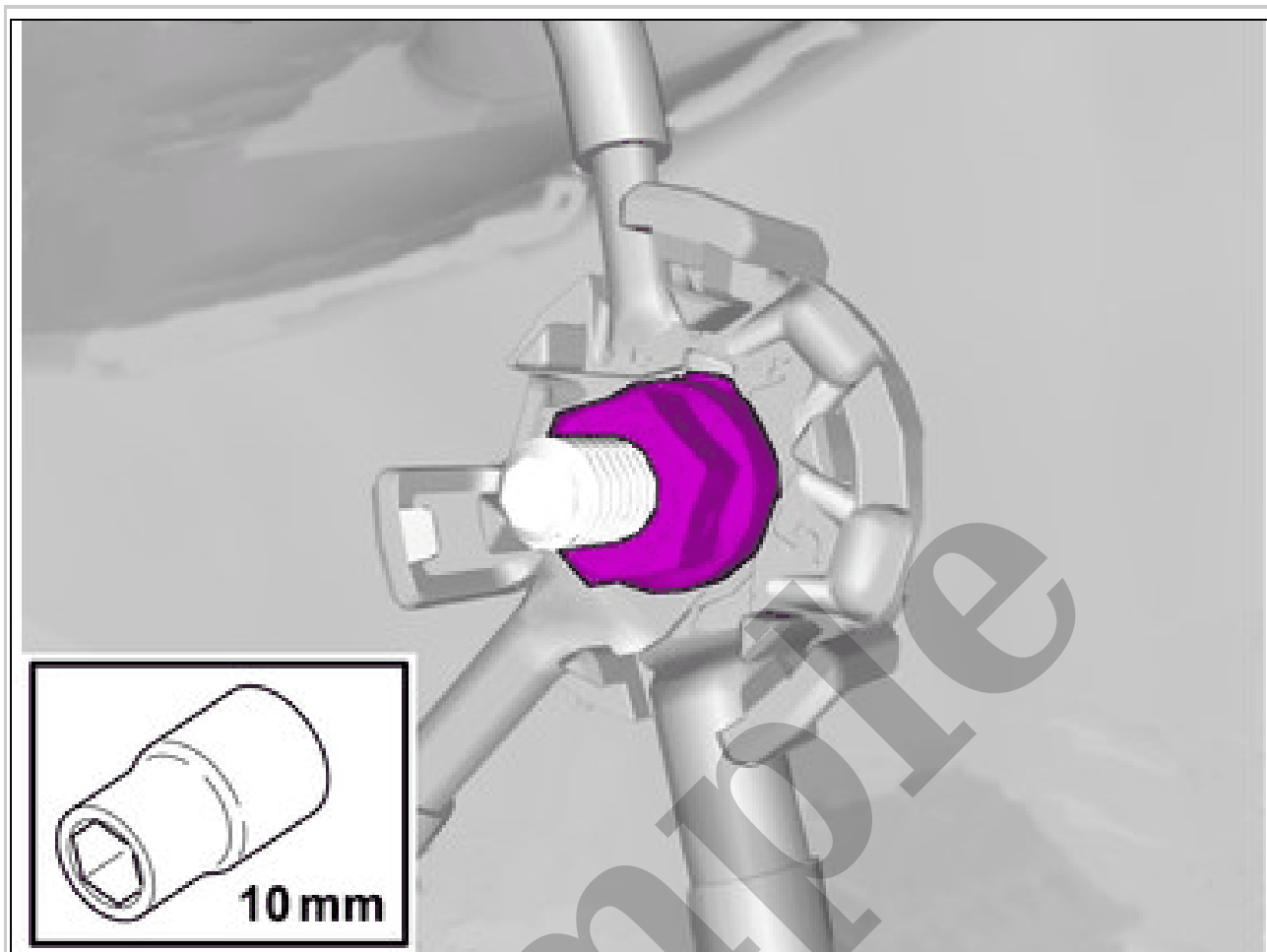

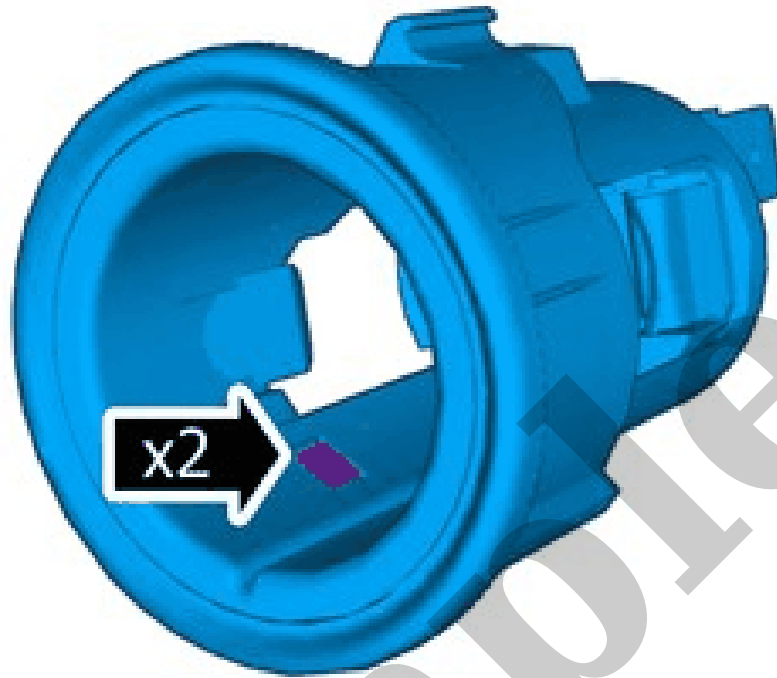

Position/route the cable as illustrated.



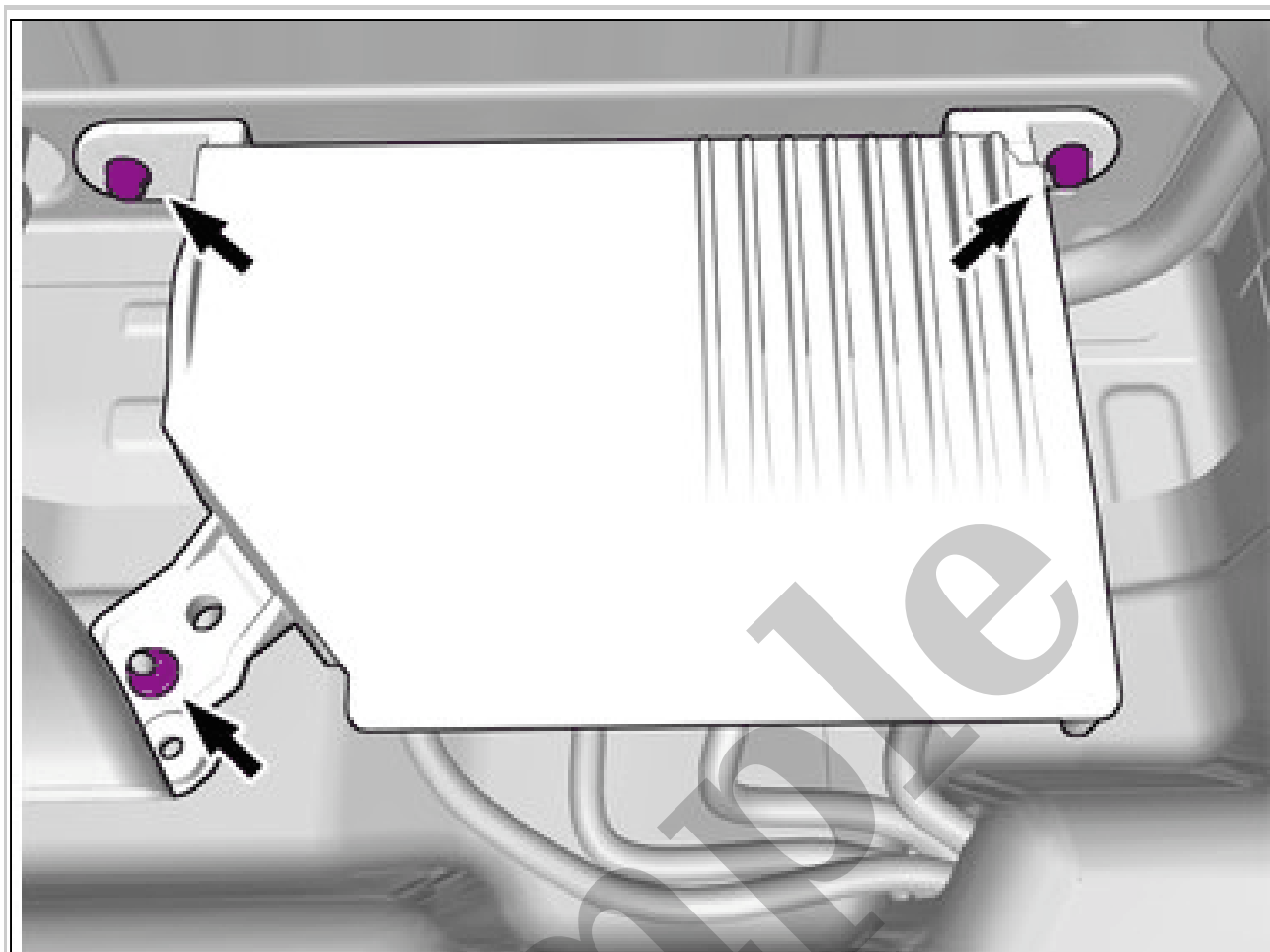

Check that the component has locked in its position.

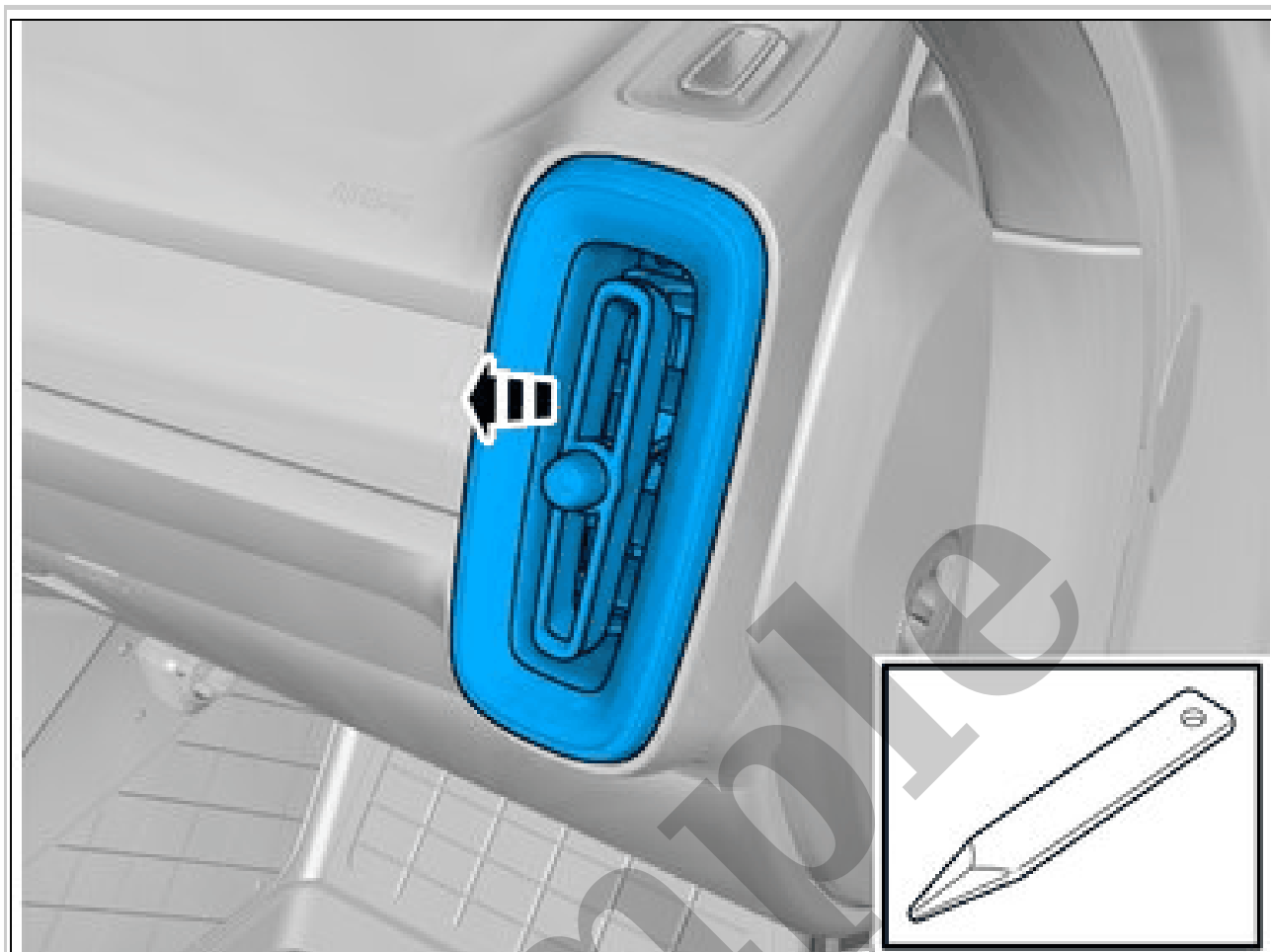

Remove the screws.

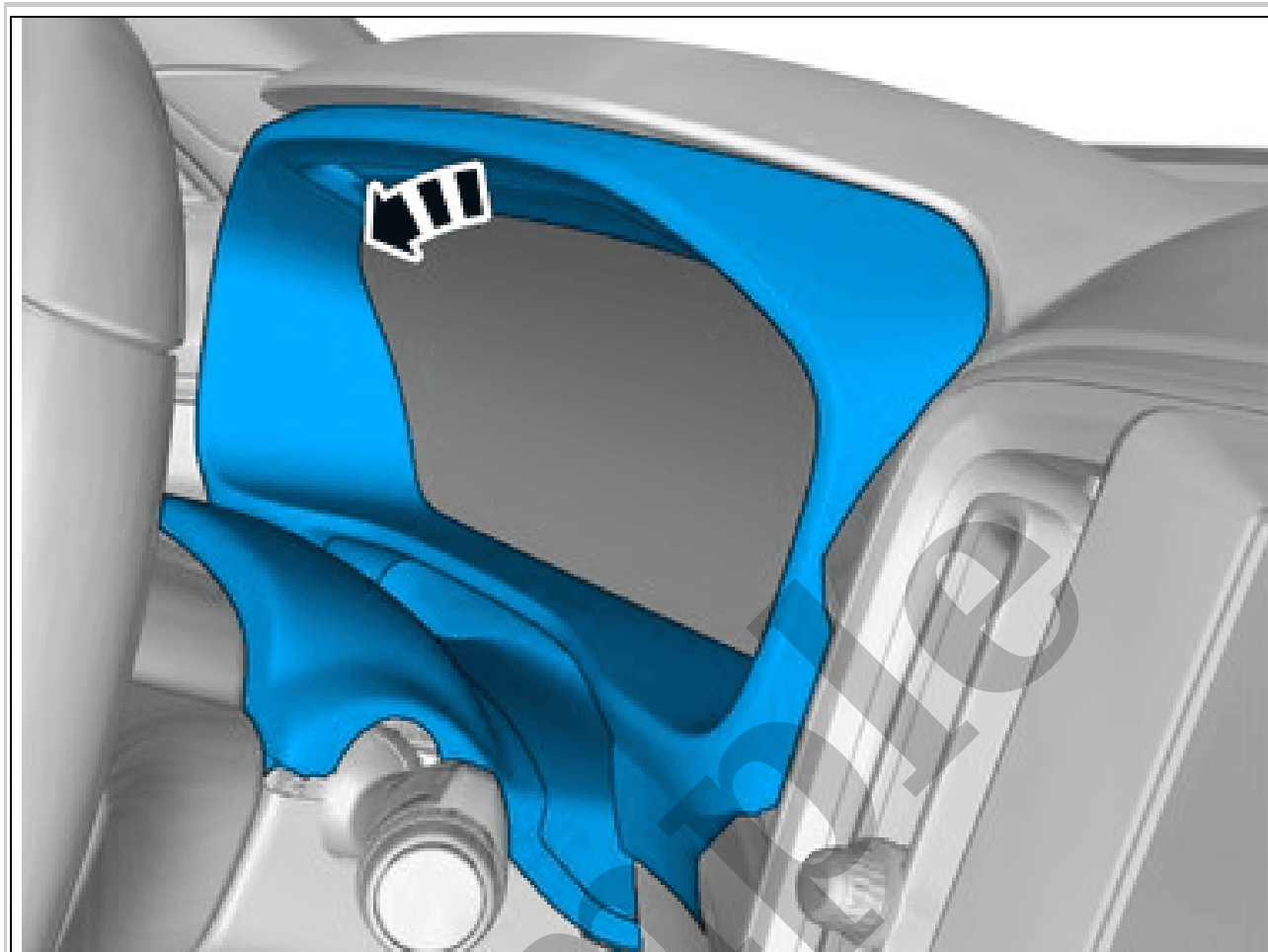
Torque: M6, 10Nm

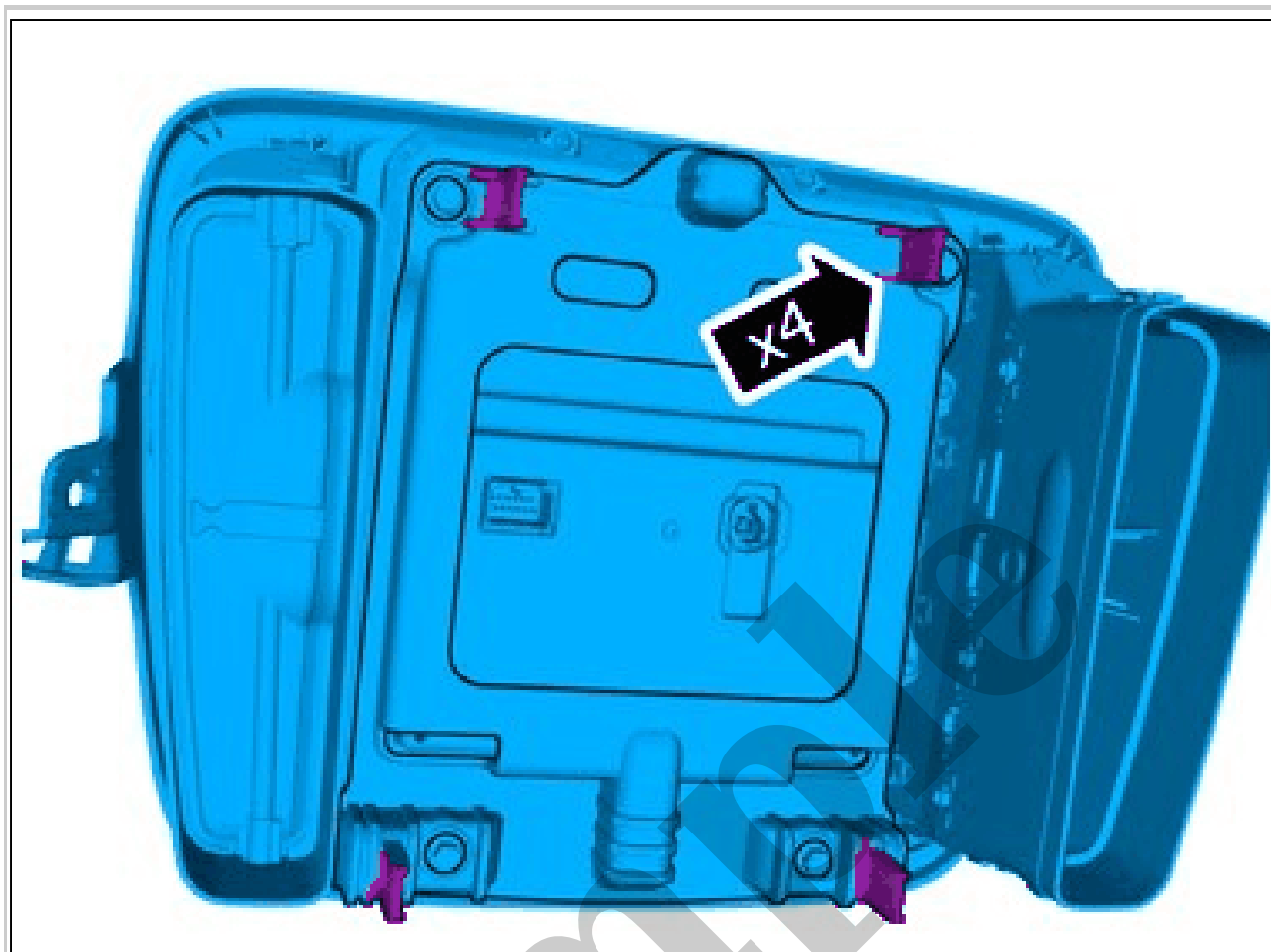
Remove the marked part.

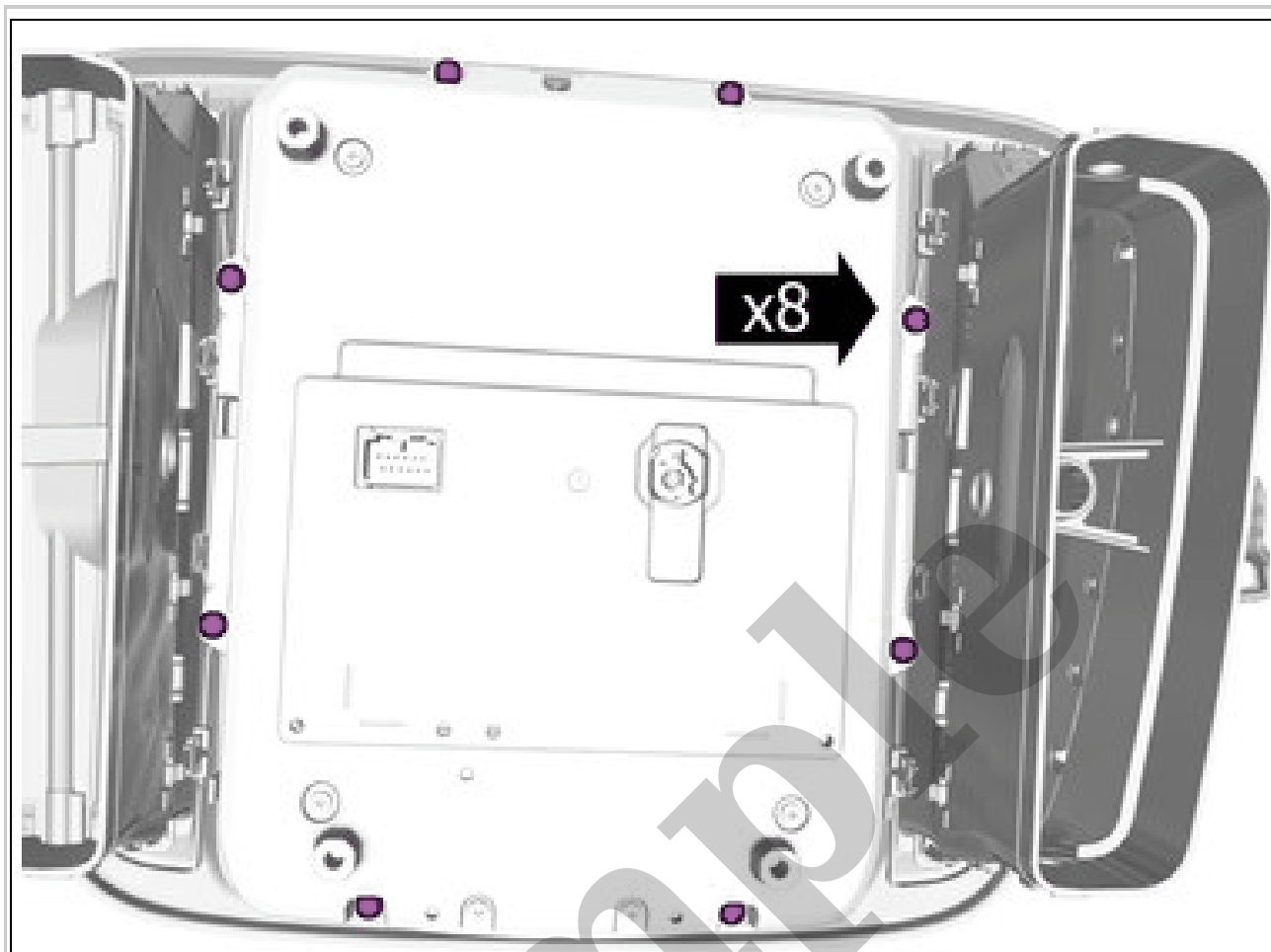

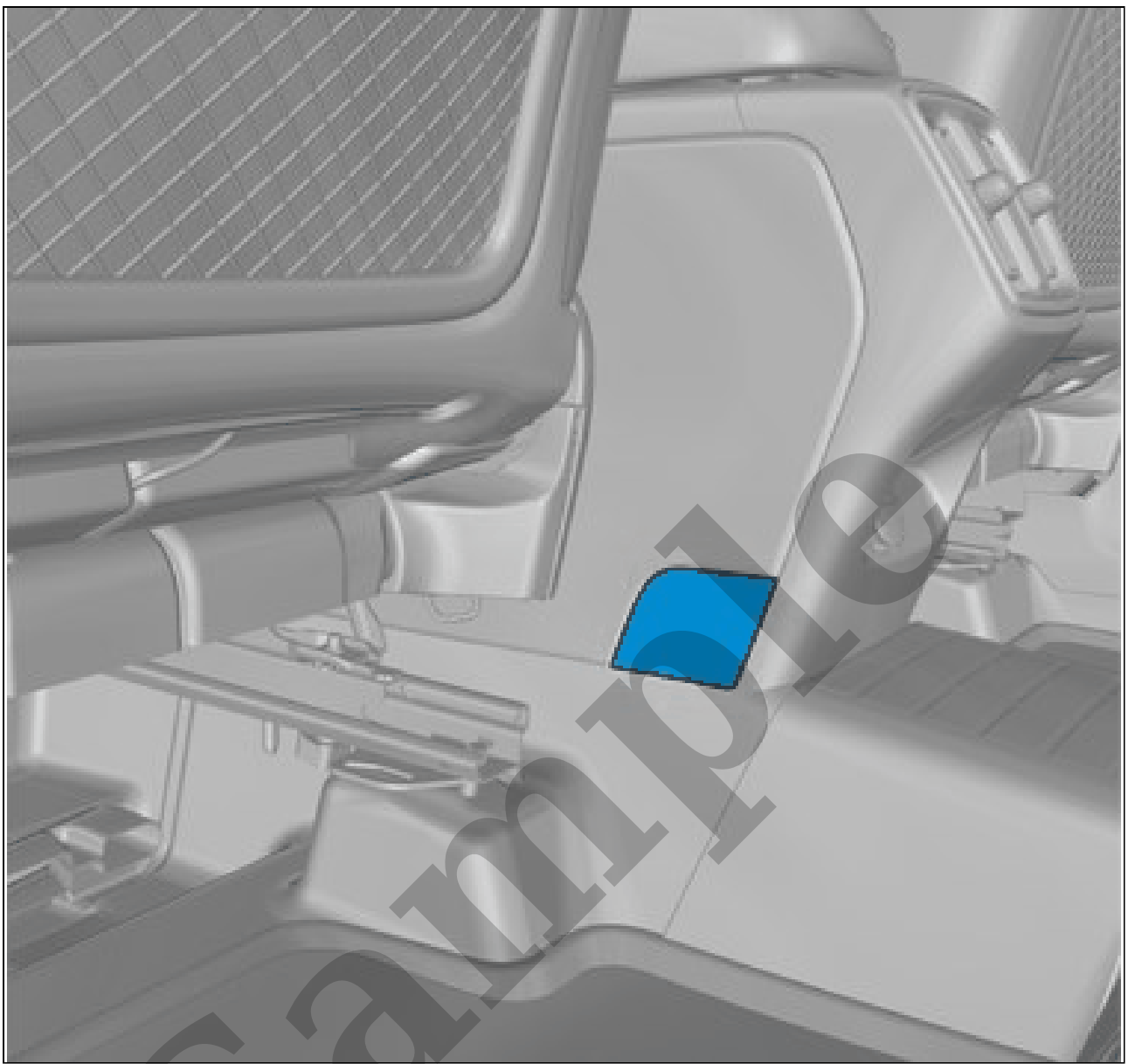
