## Removal

## **NOTE**

Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. Remove the upper active grille shutter.

Refer to: Active Grille Shutter(501-02 Front End Body Panels, Removal and Installation).


## 2. NOTE

The number and location of electrical connectors and retainers will vary depending on option content.

- 1. Disconnect the turbocharger bypass valve electrical connector.
- 2. Detach the wiring harness retainers.
- 3. Disconnect the front bumper harness electrical connector.
- 4. Disconnect the lower active grille shutter actuator electrical connector and position the front bumper wiring harness aside.

4. Remove the bolts and the front underbody skid plate.


**Torque**: 35 lb.ft (48 Nm)

5. On both sides.

Remove the bolts and the front bumper arm outer bracket.

- 1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 2. On both sides.

Install the front bumper arm outer bracket and tighten the bolts in the sequence shown.

**Torque**: 97 lb.in (11 Nm)

1. Remove the radiator grille.


## 2. NOTE

The number and location of electrical connectors and retainers will vary depending on option content.

- 1. Disconnect the turbocharger bypass valve electrical connector.
- 2. Detach the wiring harness retainers.
- 3. Disconnect the front bumper harness electrical connector.
- 4. Disconnect the lower active grille shutter actuator electrical connector and position the front bumper wiring harness aside.

## 4. If equipped.

- 1. Detach the wiring harness retainer.
- 2. Remove the engine block heater and position the engine block heater wiring harness aside.

Torque: 76 lb.ft (103 Nm)


4. If any sensor fails the check, diagnose the sensor fault.




