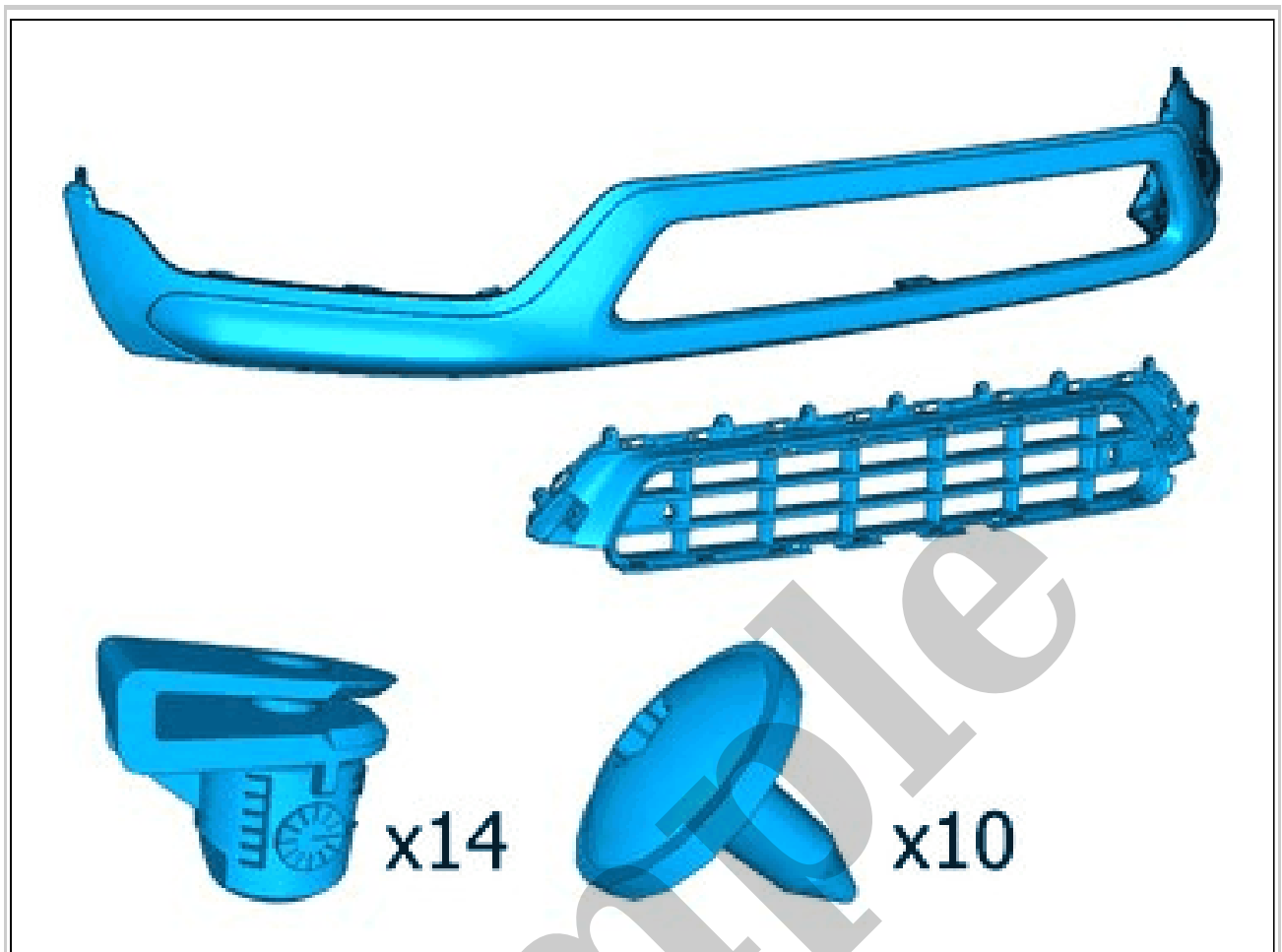

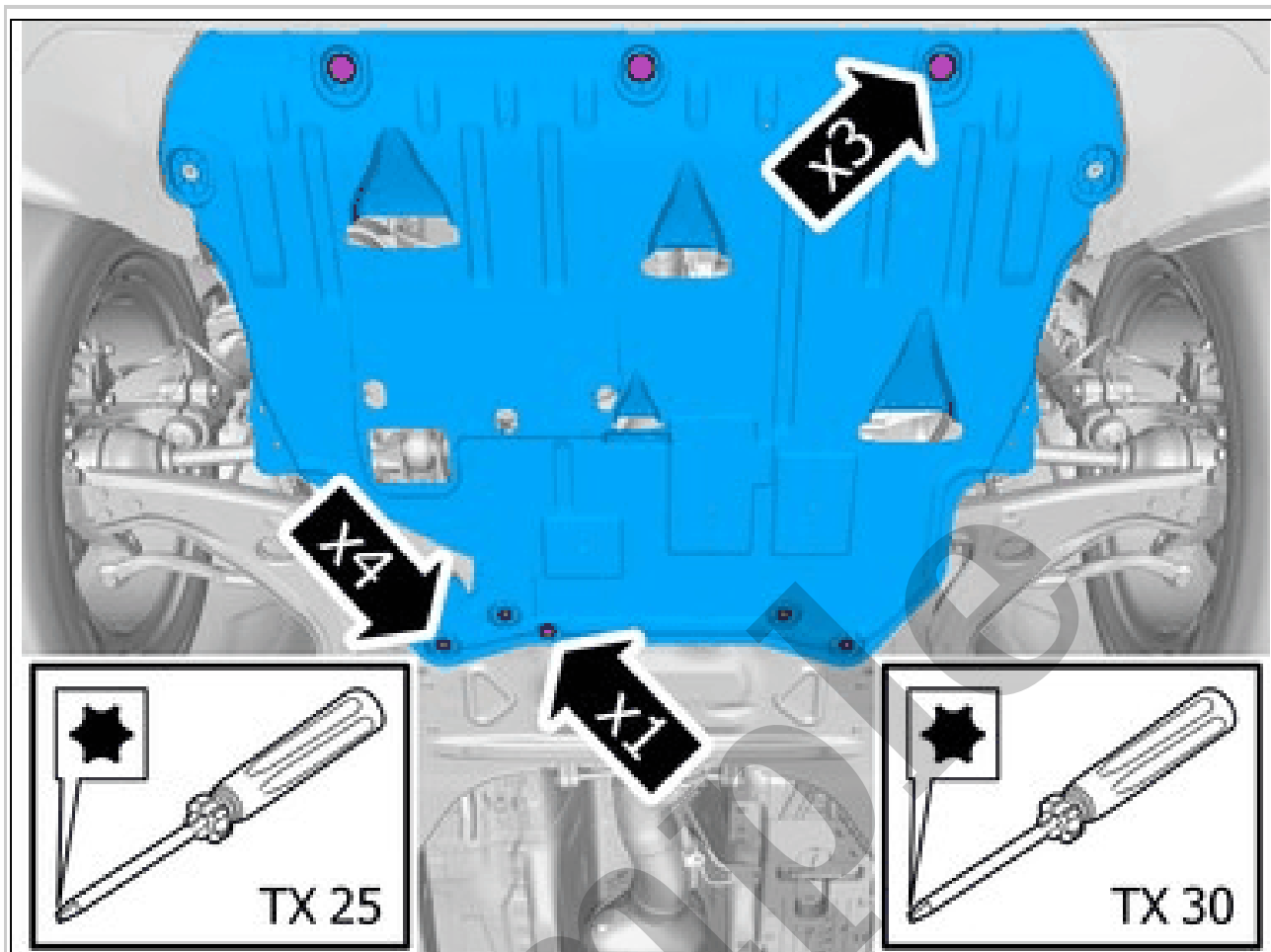

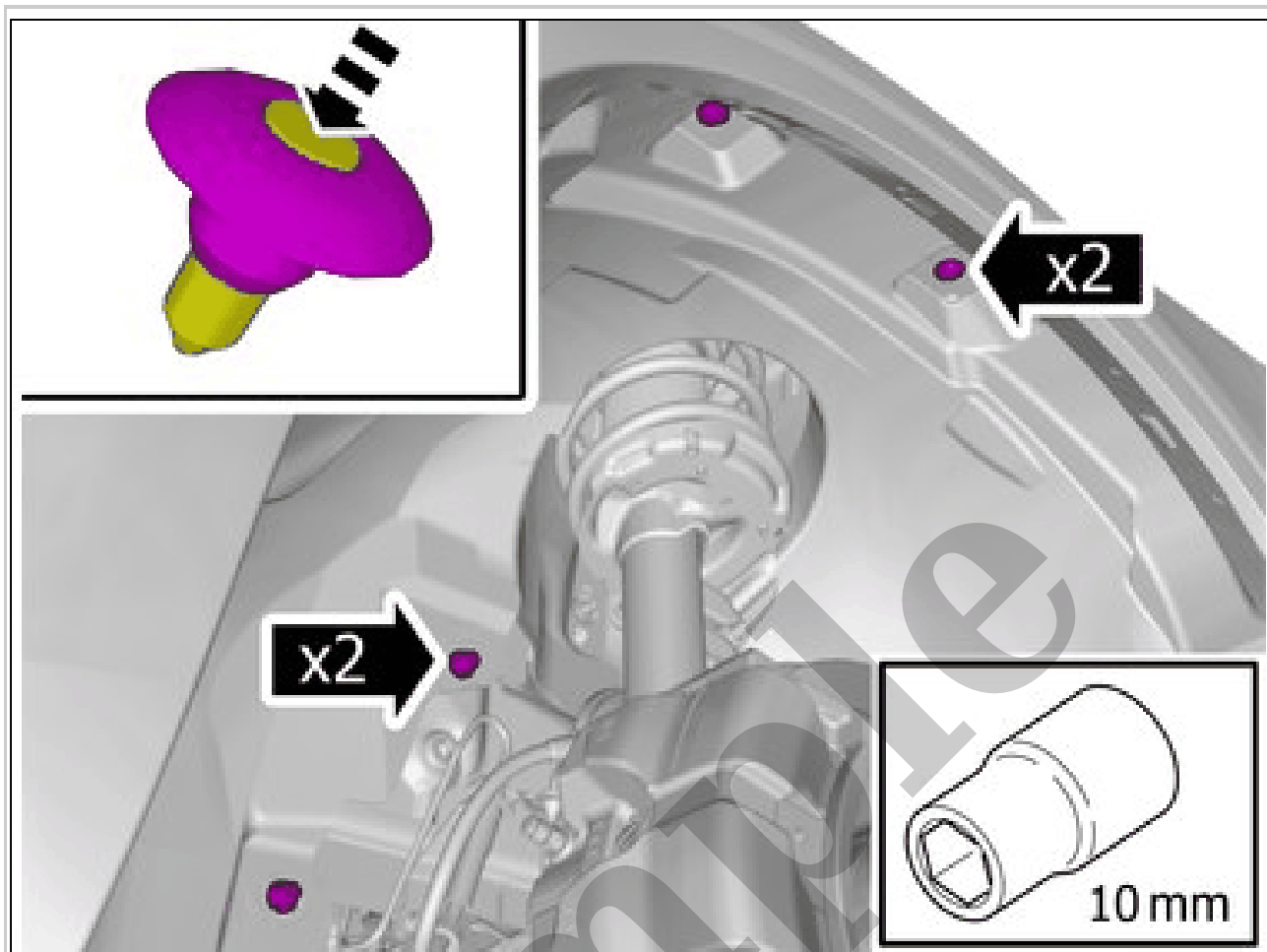
- Read through all of the instructions before starting installation.

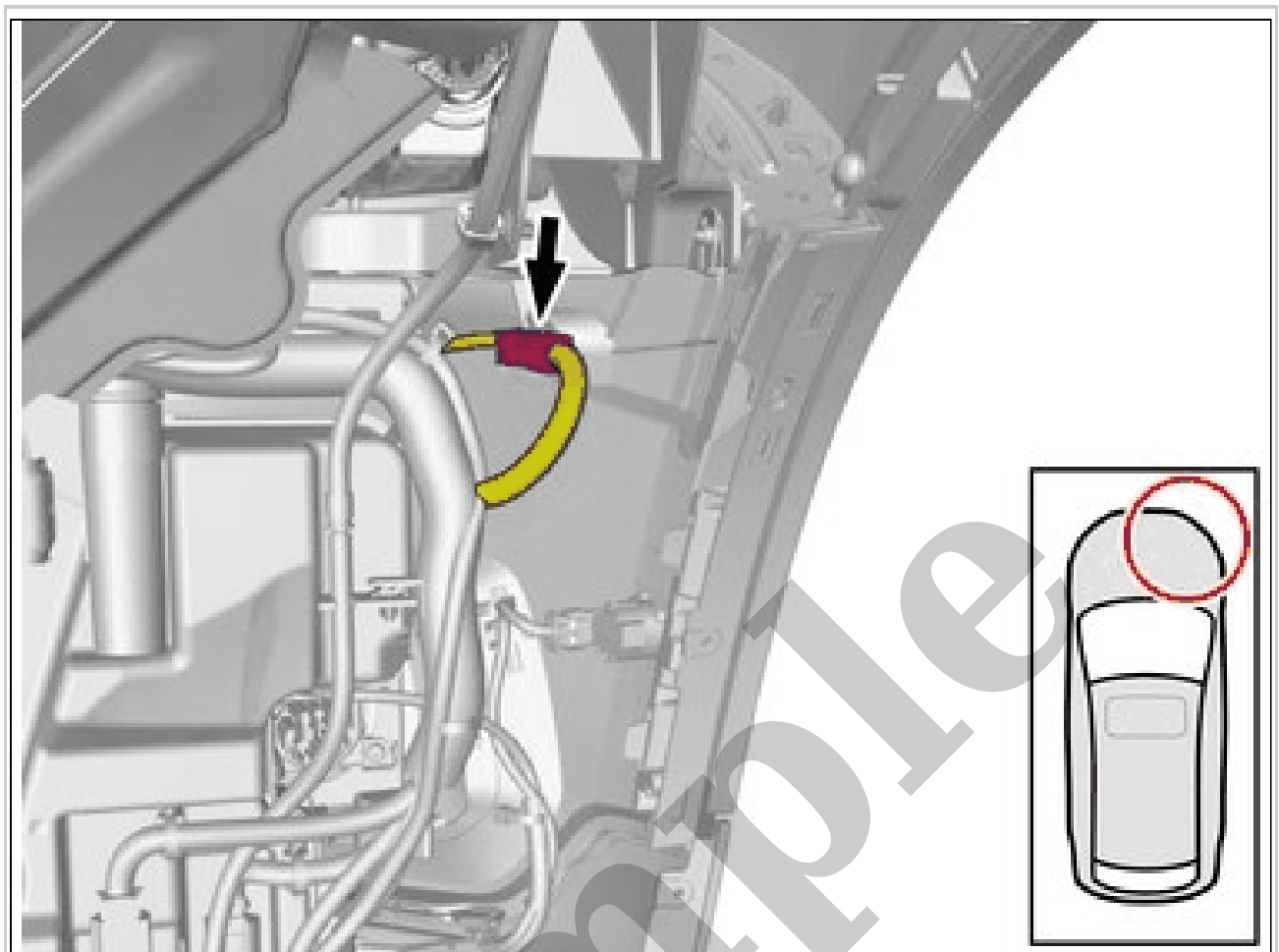

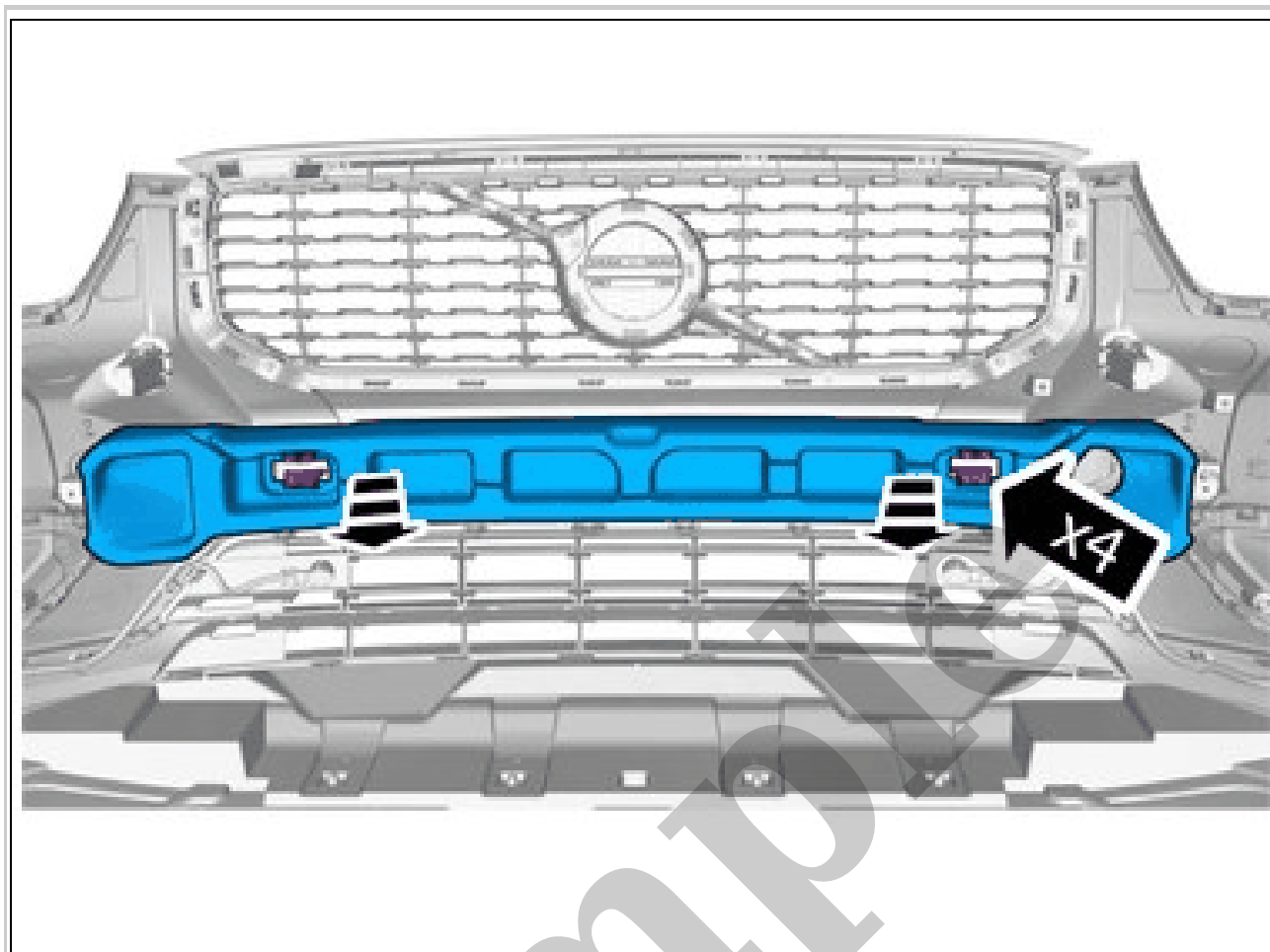
Remove the nuts.

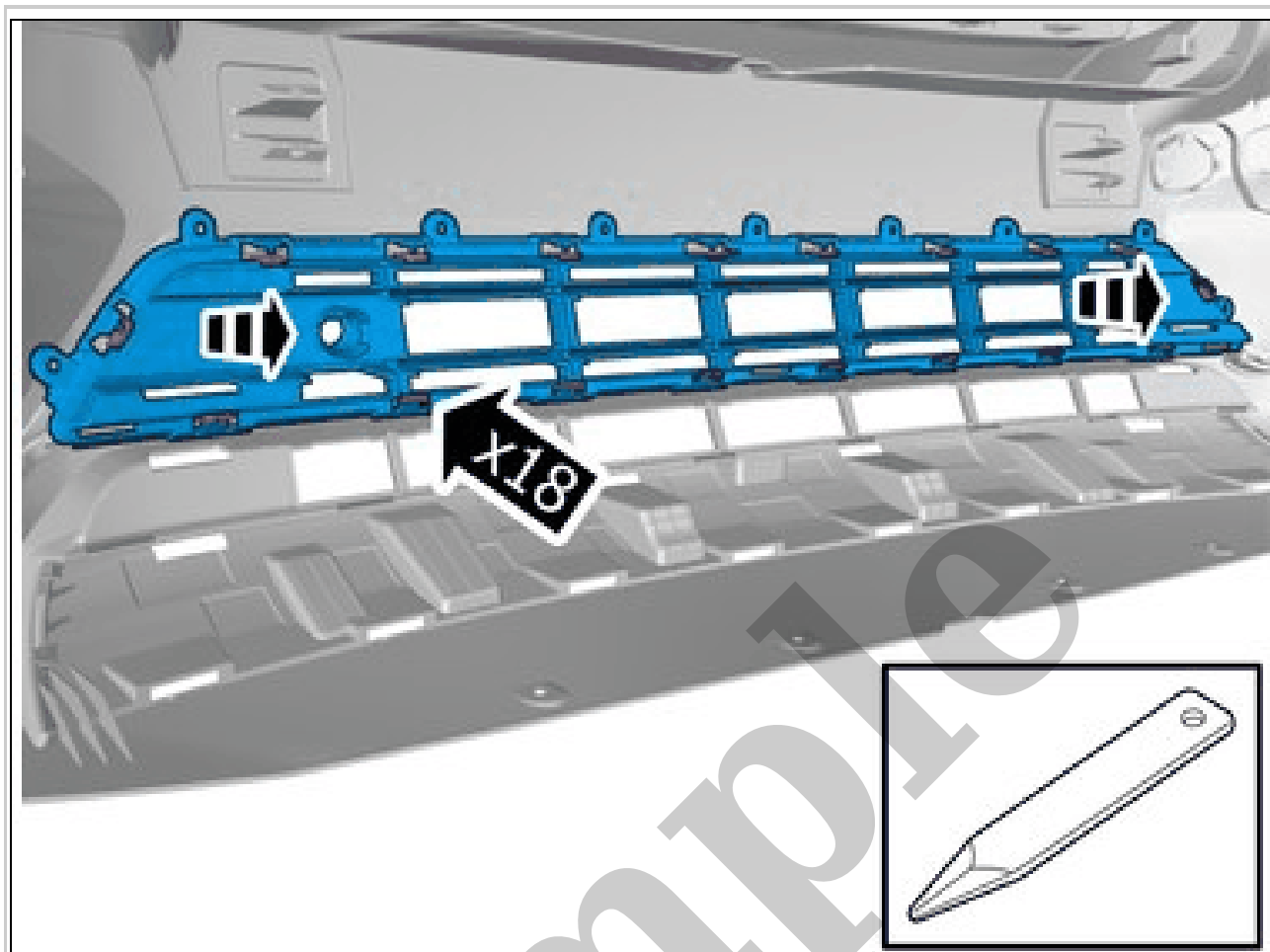
**NOTE:** *The number of connectors may vary depending on the vehicle's equipment level.*

Disconnect the connector.



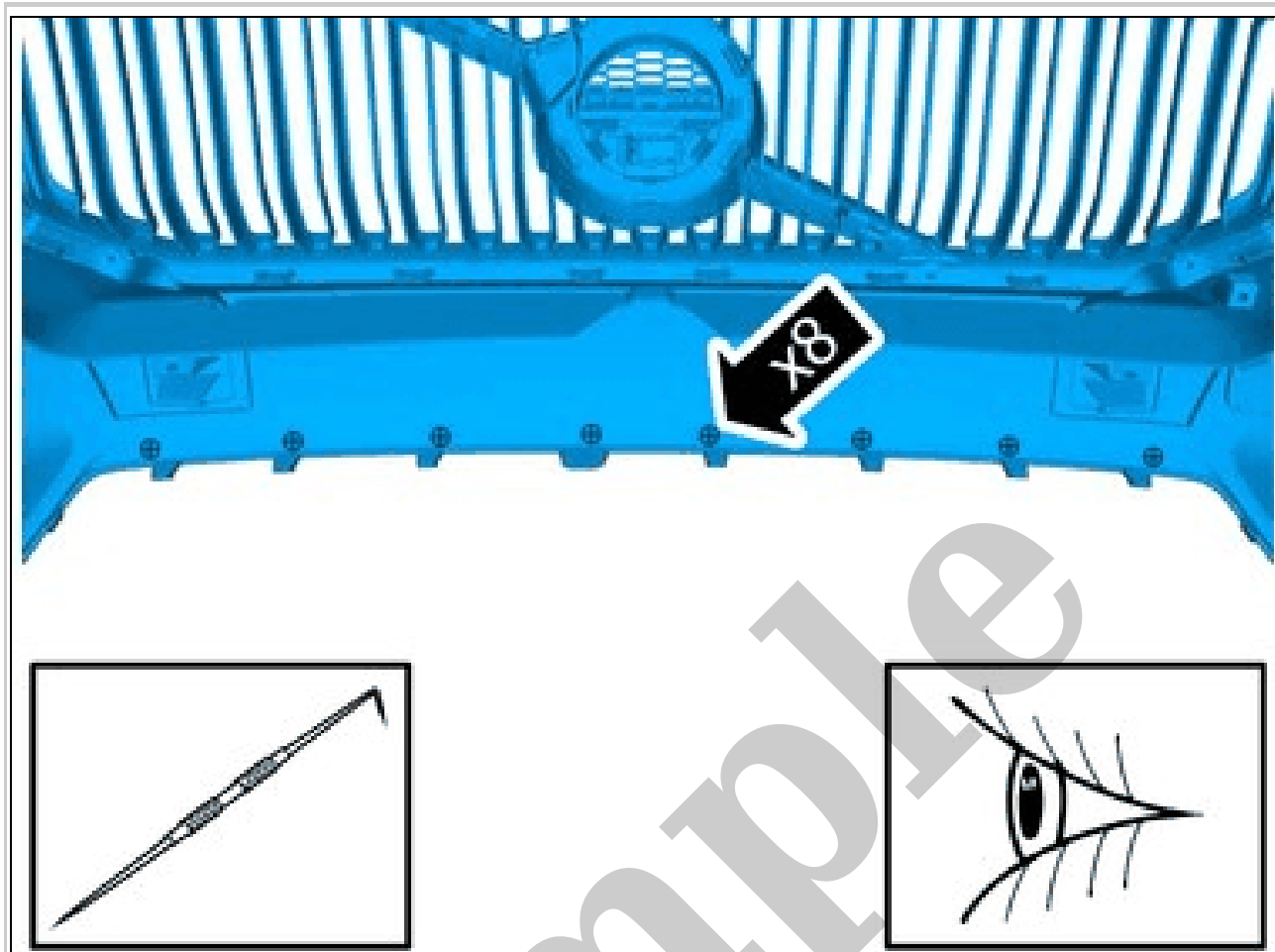

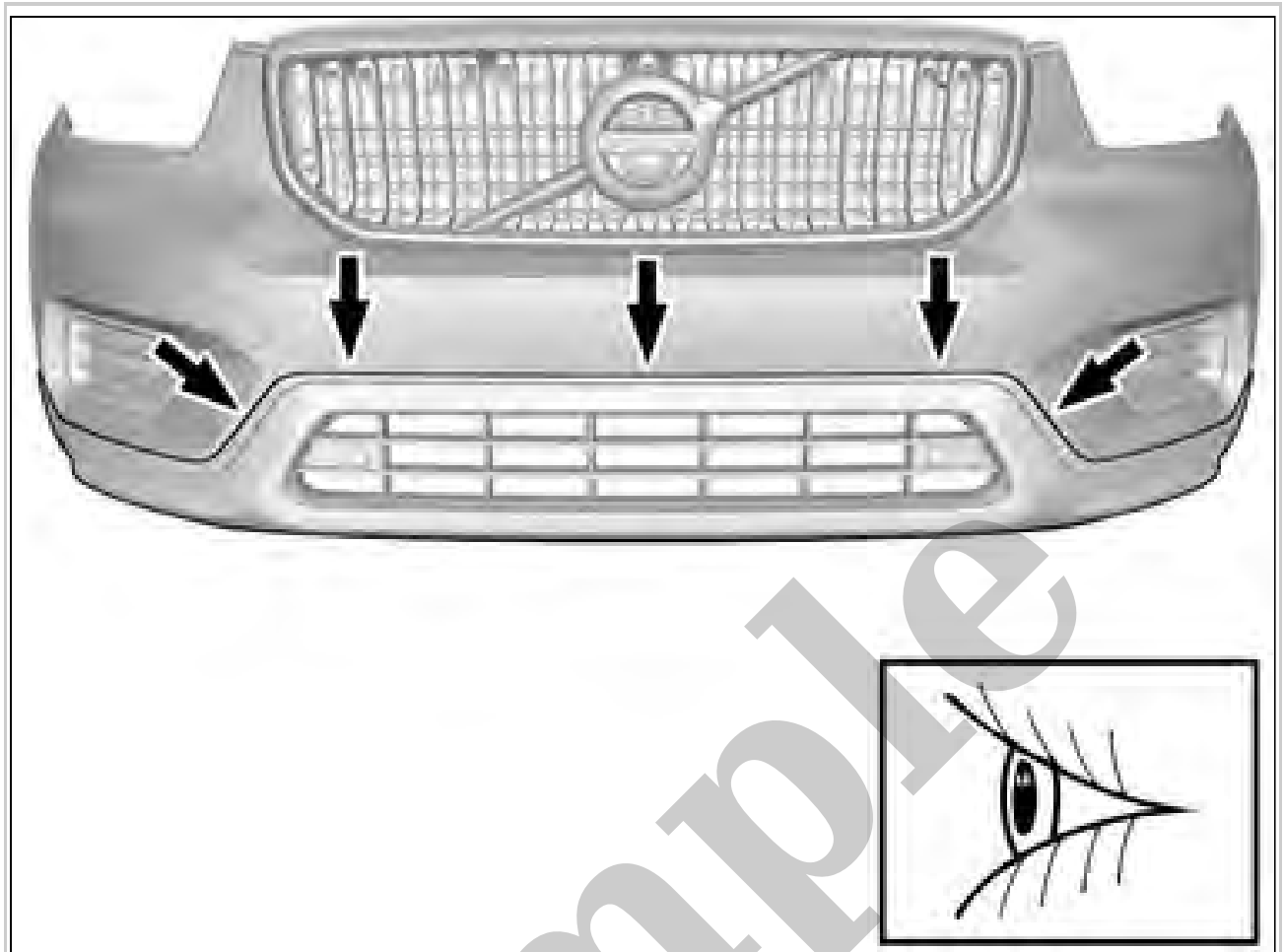

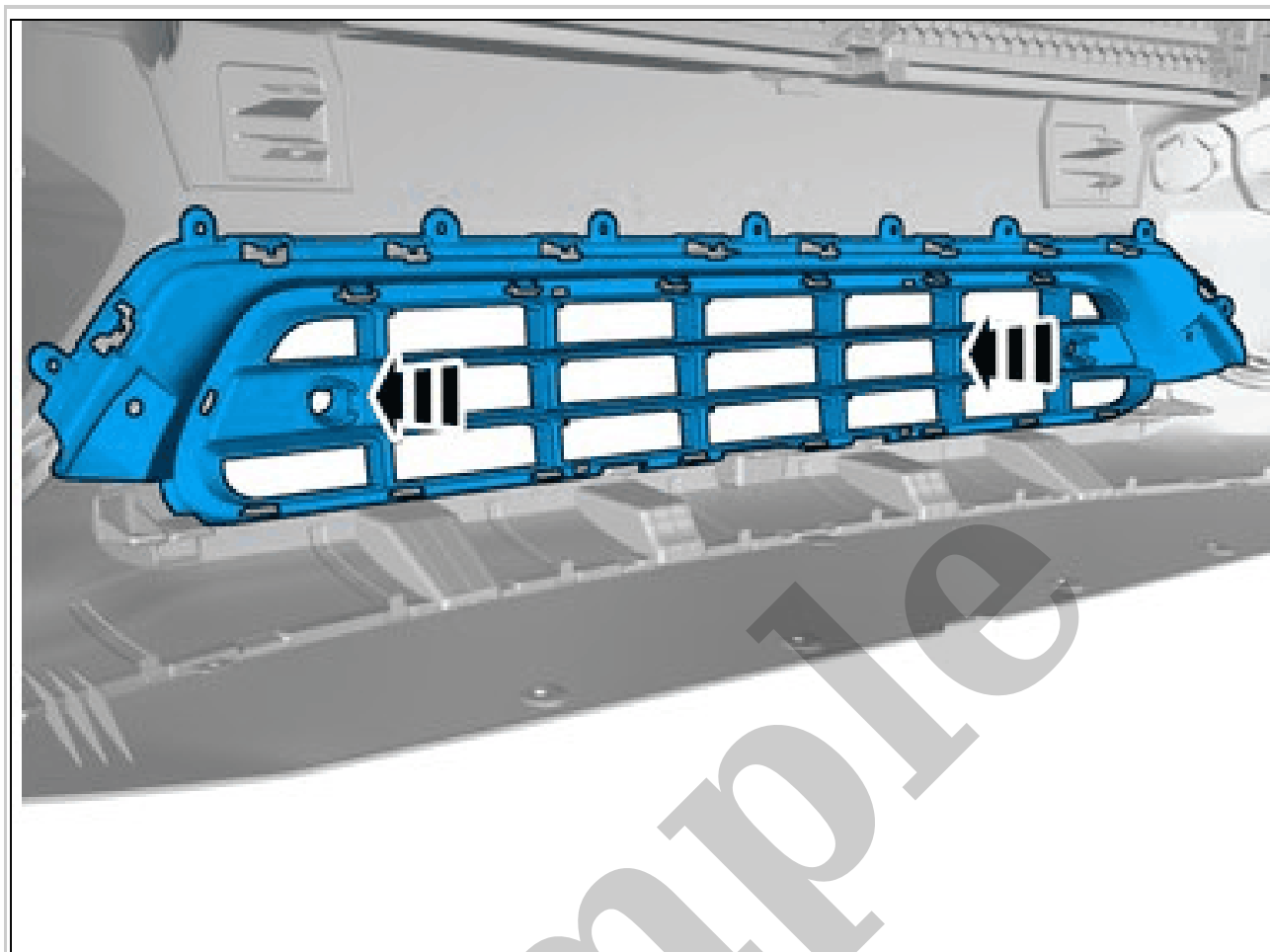
Locate relevant marking.
