






Attach the extraction hose (1) to the vacuum hose (2).

- 27. The vacuum tank has a drain valve on the bottom of the tank. Open the valve to drain coolant from the vacuum tank into a suitable container for disposal.
- 28. Install the surge tank cap.

Open the radiator drain cock (1). Radiator Drain Cock Replacement

- 5. Drain the cooling system.
- 6. Lower the vehicle.
- 7. Inspect the coolant.
- 8. Follow the appropriate procedure based on the condition of the coolant.
 - Normal in appearance—Follow the filling procedure.
 - Discolored—Follow the flush procedure. Flushing


