





 - Remove the nut and disconnect the starter motor solenoid control wire.



Remove the lower bellhousing bolt.


18. **NOTICE**

NOTE


The engine mount studs may come off with the nuts.

22. Remove the body.



Only use hand tools when loosening or tightening the engine mount through bolts or damage to the engine mount-to-cylinder block bracket can occur.


Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) engine mount through bolt.


25. Disconnect the heater hose.





26. Remove the bolt and position the heater hose and bracket aside.






29. Remove the retainers and position the high voltage wire harness and brackets from the engine.






32. Follow directions to release the quick release coupling type 5.






- 35. 1. Disconnect the PCV (positive crankcase ventilation) pressure sensor electrical connector.
