



Connect the tailgate support cable to the anchor post.







Removal


- 1. 1. Disconnect the electrical connectors from the main harness.
 - 2. Slide the harness through the box crossmember.






- 4. Remove the tailgate.
 - 1. Lift the RH (right-hand) side of the tailgate up and out.
 - 2. Rotate the tailgate approximately 10 degree from close and remove it from the vehicle.





- 3. 1. Slide the harness through the box crossmember.
 - 2. Connect the electrical connectors to the main harness.

Removal


9. Remove the telematics control unit module.




12. On Both Sides: Regular Cab:

Remove the fasteners, position aside the wiring and remove the bracket.




14. On Both Sides:
