




35. Fully extend and lower the steering column.







Vehicle with a 12 inch display is shown, vehicles with a 8 inch display are similar.


Remove the bolts, disconnect the electrical connectors and remove the FDIM (front display interface module) and centerstack trim panel as an assembly.

Torque: 55 lb.in (6.2 Nm)








