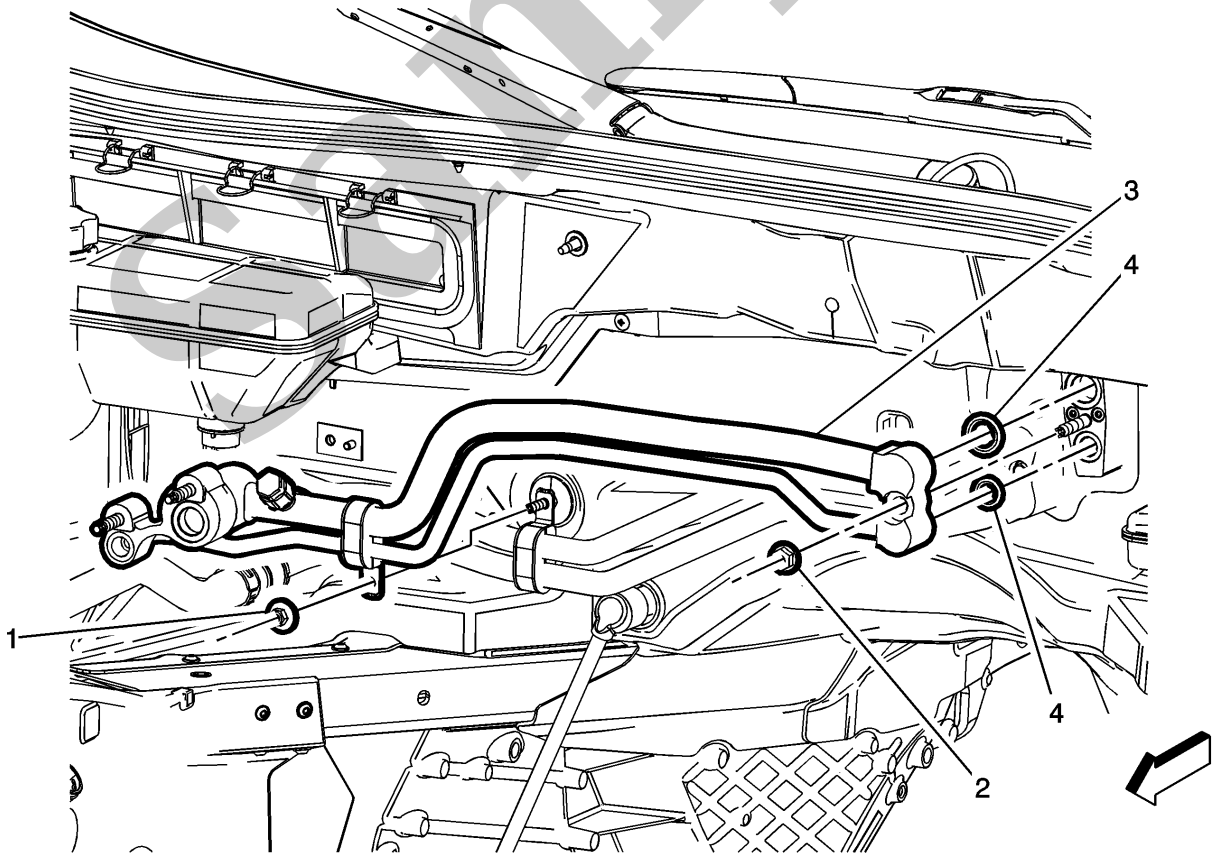

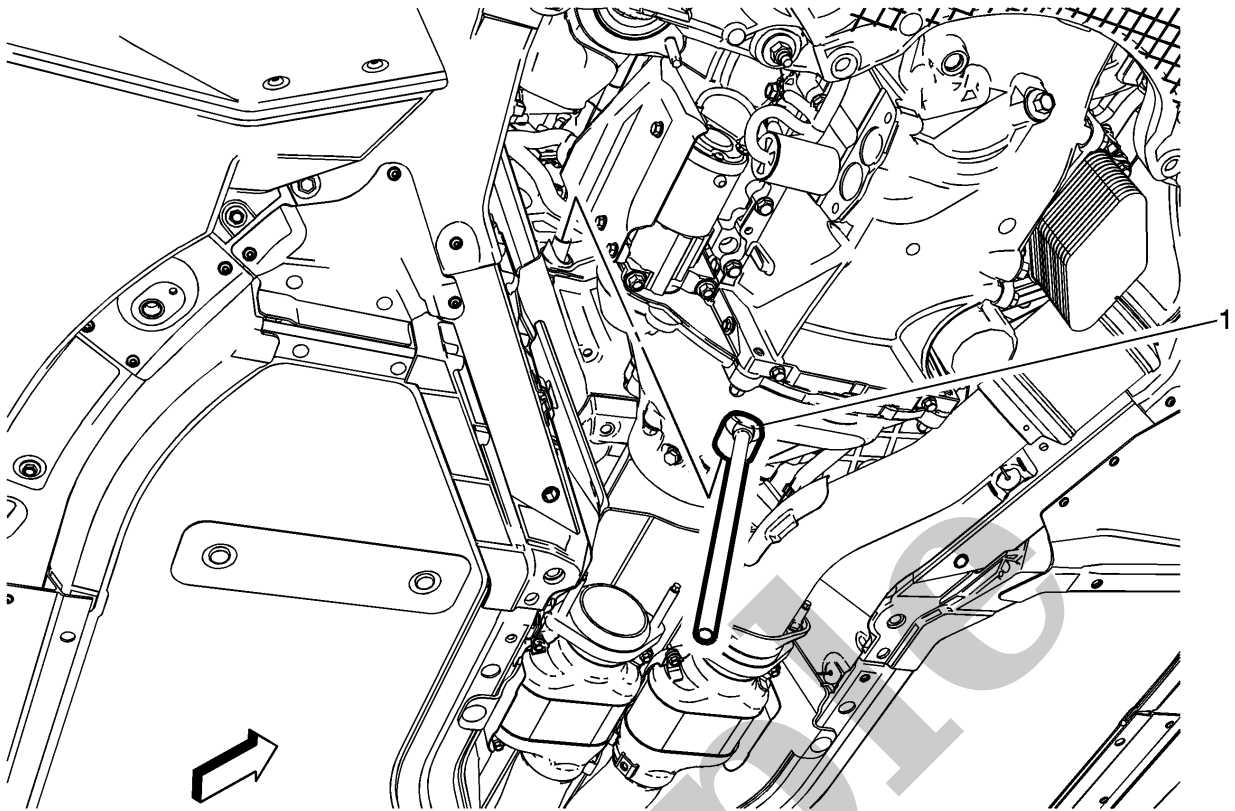

Remove the fuel pump Insulator (1). [Fuel Pump Insulator Replacement](#)

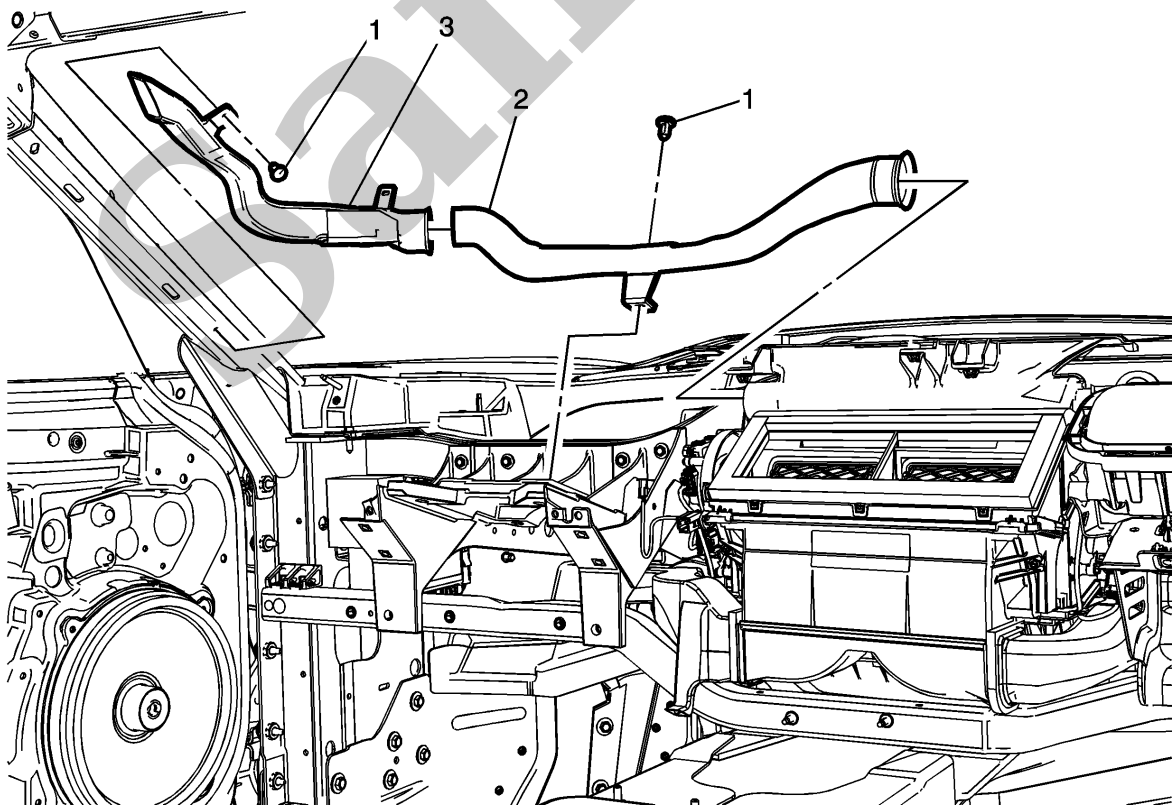

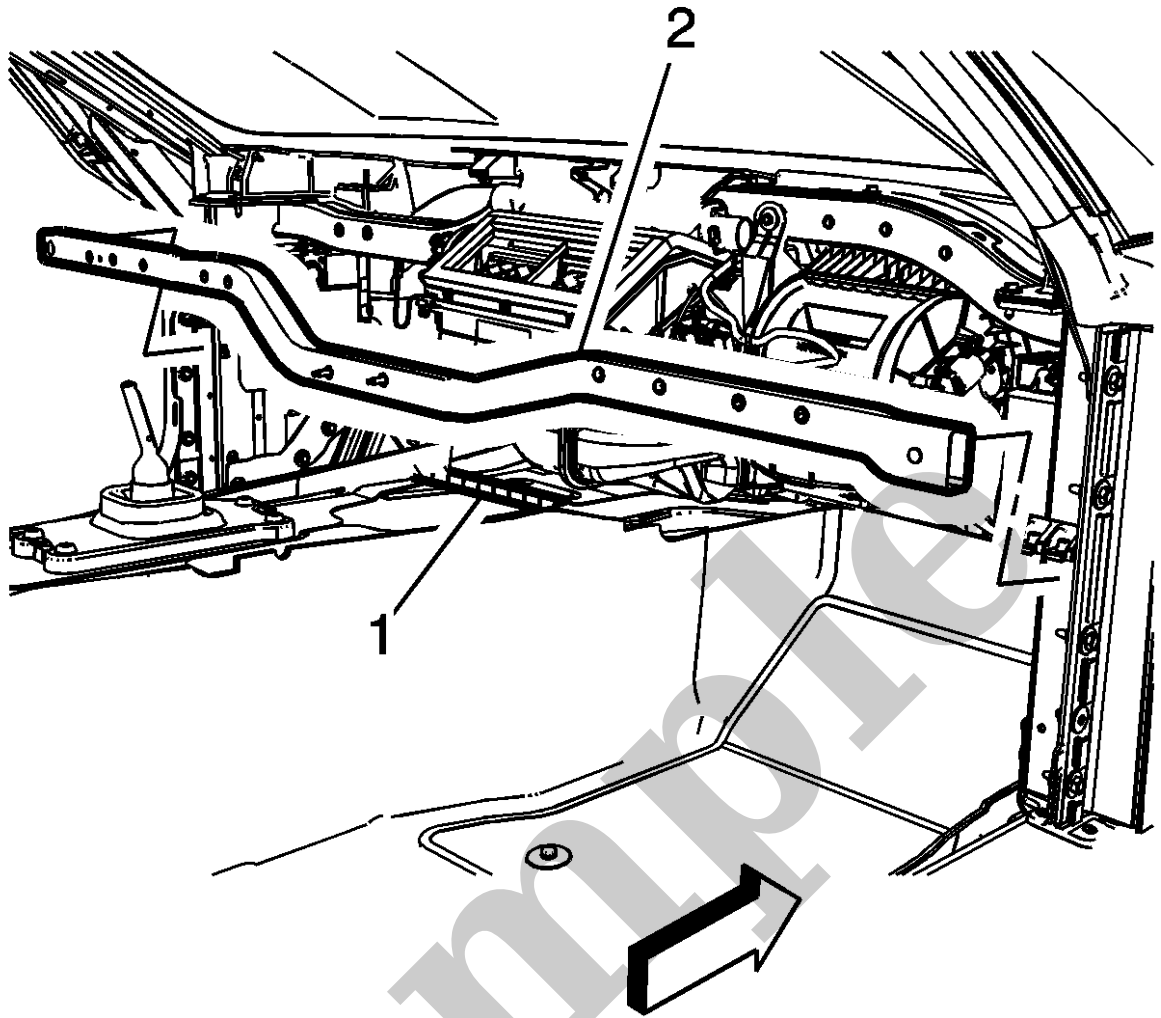
