

5. Release the B-pillar trim panel clips.

6. **NOTE**

Seats removed for clarity.

Remove the B-pillar trim panel.

- 1. Release the B-pillar trim panel clip from the tether clip.
- 2. Rotate the tether clip line to align the end with the opening.
- 3. Slide the tether clip end out of the B-pillar trim panel.
- 4. Feed the rear seatbelt retractor and pretensioner through the opening in the B-pillar trim panel.

2. Inspect and position the front and rear door weather strip lip so that it overlaps the top of the B-pillar trim panel.



2. Remove the front scuff plate trim panel.

3. Remove the rear scuff plate trim panel.


4. Release the tabs and remove the front seatbelt retractor and pretensioner opening trim cover.

 - 1. Release the lower B-pillar trim panel clips.


Upper B-Pillar Trim Panel

9. Release the upper B-pillar trim panel clips.

10. NOTICE

The upper B-pillar trim panel must be positioned downward to allow the upper clips to release correctly. Failure to follow this direction may cause damage to the upper B-pillar trim panel.


Slide the upper B-pillar trim panel down, aligning the clips to the slots in the sheet metal.

1. NOTE

During installation, make sure the seatbelt webbing is not twisted and the seatbelts and buckles are accessible to the occupants.

To install, reverse the removal procedure.

2. Inspect and position the front and rear door weather strip lip so that it overlaps the top of the B-pillar trim panels.



3. NOTE

The seat backrest latch is only accessible when the seat cushion is raised.

NOTE


During installation the striker should be in its lowest position for the latch to engage.

Fold the LH (left-hand) rear seat backrest down.

- 1. Raise the seat cushion.
- 2. Release the backrest latch.
- 3. Fold the backrest down.



5. Release the C-pillar trim panel clips.

- 6. Remove the C-pillar trim panel.
 - 1. Release the C-pillar trim panel clip from the tether clip.
 - 2. Rotate the tether clip line to align the end with the opening.
 - 3. Slide the tether clip end out of the C-pillar trim panel.
 - 4. Feed the rear seatbelt retractor and pretensioner through the opening in the C-pillar trim panel.
