


- The intermediate shaft(s)

After disconnecting these components, do not rotate the steering wheel or move the front tires and wheels. Failure to follow this procedure may cause the SIR coil assembly to become un-centered and cause possible damage to the SIR coil. If you think the SIR coil has became un-centered, refer to your specific SIR coil's centering procedure to re-center SIR Coil.


With the front wheels of the vehicle in the straight ahead position, use the **CH-42640** *anti-rotation pin* to lock the steering column.

- 9. Disconnect the battery negative cable. Battery Negative Cable Disconnection and Connection
- 10. Disconnect any electrical connectors as necessary.
- 11. Intermediate Steering Shaft@Steering Column »Separate— Intermediate Steering Shaft Replacement







Steering Column Bracket Bolt(1) »Remove[3x]

Remove the lower steering column telescope actuator bracket bolt (1) from the top of the steering column telescope actuator bracket.

- 21. Guide the steering column downward into the dash and remove the lower steering column telescope actuator bracket bolt (1) from the bottom of the steering column telescope actuator bracket.
- 22. Remove the steering column telescope actuator motor (2) from the vehicle.
