



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40. • Loosen the clamps. Disconnect the LH (left-hand) TC (turbocharger) outlet tube from the bracket grommet and remove the LH (left-hand) TC (turbocharger) outlet tube.


• Follow directions to release the quick release coupling type 8.

43. Disconnect the coolant hose and position aside.




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44. Disconnect the coolant hoses and remove.


47. Position out the engine wiring harness.

- 50. Position the B+ wire protective cover and remove the nut and the B+ wire.
 - Disconnect the starter generator electrical connector.




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
51. **NOTE**

Make sure that the mating faces are clean and free of foreign material.

Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) catalytic converter flange nuts.



53. Remove the top bellhousing bolts and position aside the bracket.




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54. Remove the RH (right-hand) bellhousing bolt.

Support the bellhousing of the transmission with a suitable floor jack and a block of wood.

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
57. NOTICE

Only use hand tools when loosening or tightening the engine mount-to-frame bolts or damage to the engine mount-to-frame nut plate can occur.

NOTE

Leave the LH (left-hand) engine mount in place.

Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) engine mount bolts.



59. Install the LH (left-hand) lifting eye.

Use Special Service Tool: 303-1654 Lift Eyes

Torque: 18 lb.ft (25 Nm)

61. **NOTE**


The use of a ratchet strap may be needed to level the engine.

NOTE

Use a commercially available quick link on the chain to minimize the spread of the chain.

• Install the engine spreader bar and the floor crane.

Use the General Equipment: Floor Crane




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
62. Using the floor crane, lift eyes and the engine spreader bar, lift the engine.
