




Disconnect the steering column upper shaft from the steering column.


5. Remove the steering column upper shaft.


- 1. Connect the steering column upper shaft to the steering column.

Torque: 106 lb.in (12 Nm)

4. NOTICE

Make sure that the steering wheel does not rotate or damage to the clockspring may occur.

Secure the steering wheel.

- 5. Remove the steering column opening lower trim panel.
 - 1. Unclip and lower the steering column opening lower trim panel.
 - 2. Remove the retainers and the steering column opening lower trim panel.

7. Remove the GSM (gear shift module).



8. NOTE

Vehicles equipped with power adjustable steering column shown, all others similar. Includes deployable column connector.

Disconnect the electrical connectors, release the retainers and position the wire harness aside.



Installation

- 1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 2. Torque the steering column retainers following the sequence shown.

Torque: 18 lb.ft (25 Nm)

- 4. Move the column in the same direction until it reaches the end of travel and hold the switch for 2 seconds after the motor has reached the end of travel. This clears any unintended soft stops.
- 5. Repeat the sequence moving the column up and down.



3. Remove the steering column shrouds.

4. Disconnect the clockspring electrical connectors.

5. **NOTE**

The mounting bolt in not replaceable without disassembling the adaptive steering wheel assembly.

Remove the bolt and the steering wheel.

Torque: 46 lb.ft (62.5 Nm)
