


### Vehicles equipped with an instrument panel center speaker

19. Remove the screws, release the clips and remove the instrument panel center speaker mounting plate.


21. Remove the screws, release the clips and remove the upper instrument panel tray.


22. Disconnect the electrical connectors.






25. Remove the bolts, disconnect the electrical connector and remove the information and entertainment display unit.

**Torque**: 55 lb.in (6.2 Nm)
















6. On vehicles without a floor console.

Remove the bolt.


