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

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



Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) catalytic converter flange nuts.



Remove and discard the RH (right-hand) catalytic converter flange nuts.





45. Disconnect the engine clutch pressure sensor from the transmission.




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

Remove the lower bellhousing bolt.




49. Remove the LH (left-hand) side bellhousing bolts and the shift cable bracket.

Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) engine mount through bolt.


54. **NOTICE**

Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) engine mount bolts.




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55. Remove the right rear ignition coil.



Removal

NOTICE

During engine repair procedures, cleanliness is extremely important. Any foreign material, including any material created while cleaning gasket surfaces, that enters the oil passages, coolant passages or the oil pan, can cause engine failure.

NOTE

If the RH (right-hand) camshafts are being serviced at the same time as the LH (left-hand) camshafts, remove the RH (right-hand) camshafts first. Refer to the procedure in this section.

NOTE

If the components are to be reinstalled, they must be installed in their original locations.

1. With the vehicle in NEUTRAL, position it on a hoist.

2. Release the fuel system pressure.
