

15. If a new intake manifold was installed, road test the vehicle.




4. Remove and discard the engine oil filter.


5. Disconnect the block heater cord.

If metal or foreign material is present in the oil cooler, mechanical concerns exist. To diagnose the mechanical concerns refer to section 303-00.

Remove the retainer and the oil cooler.


2. Remove the hose locking pliers.

Stage 2: 180 °





5. Install the air cleaner outlet pipe LH (left-hand).









5. • If equipped.


Remove the bolts.

• Release the retainer and remove the transmission housing cover.






8. Loosen the upper bellhousing bolts 5 mm (0.19 in).
