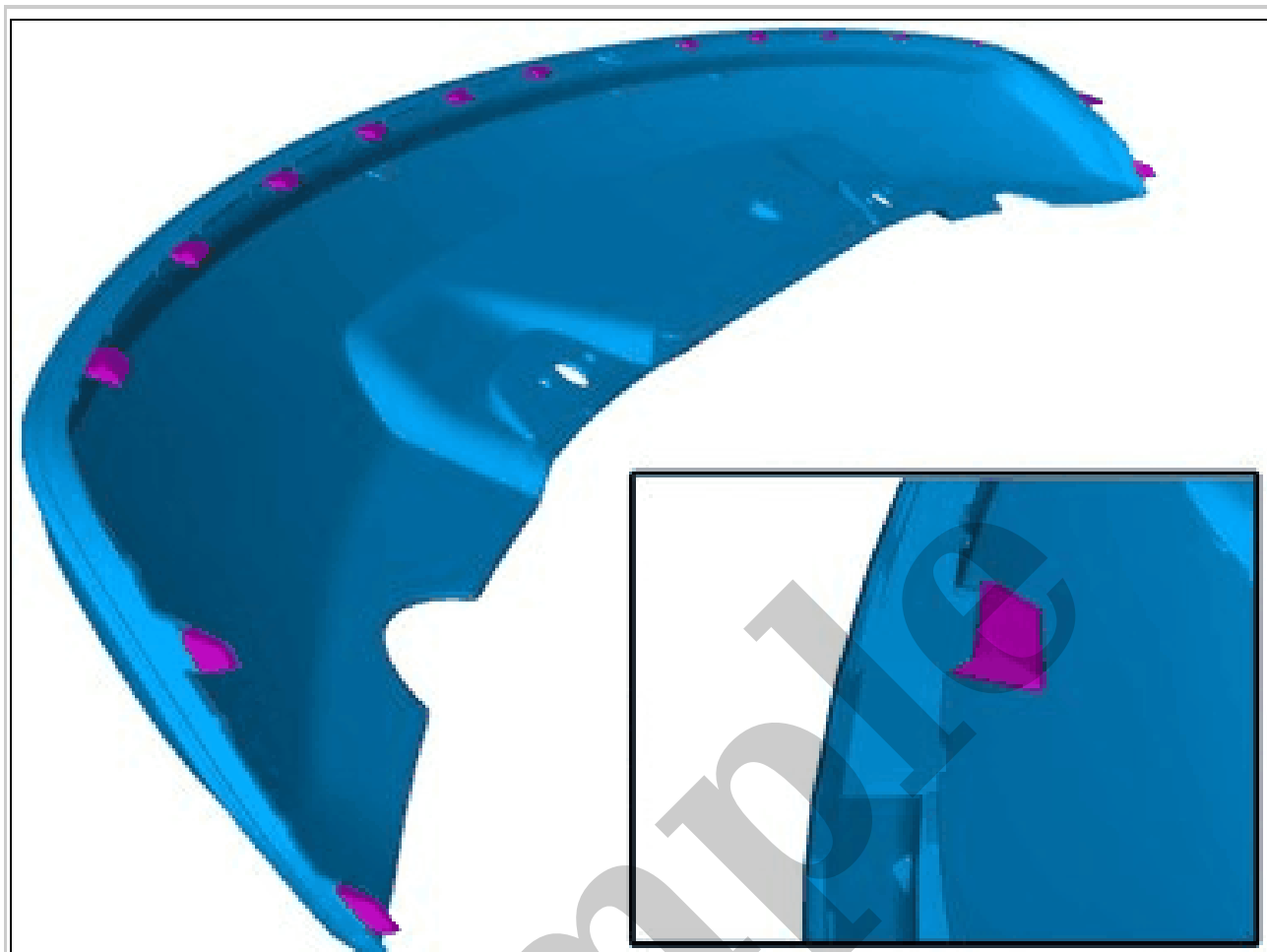

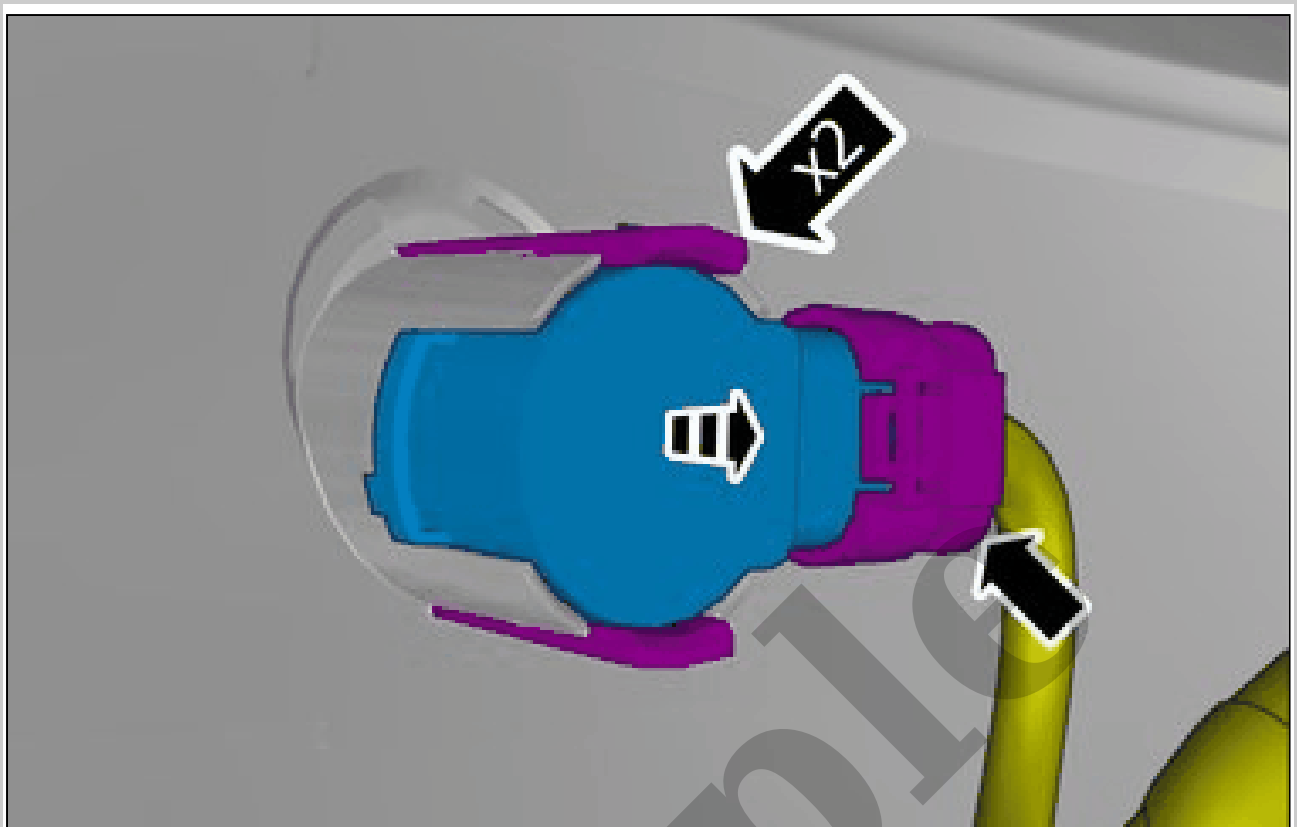

**NOTE:** *The graphic shows the back of the component before removal.*

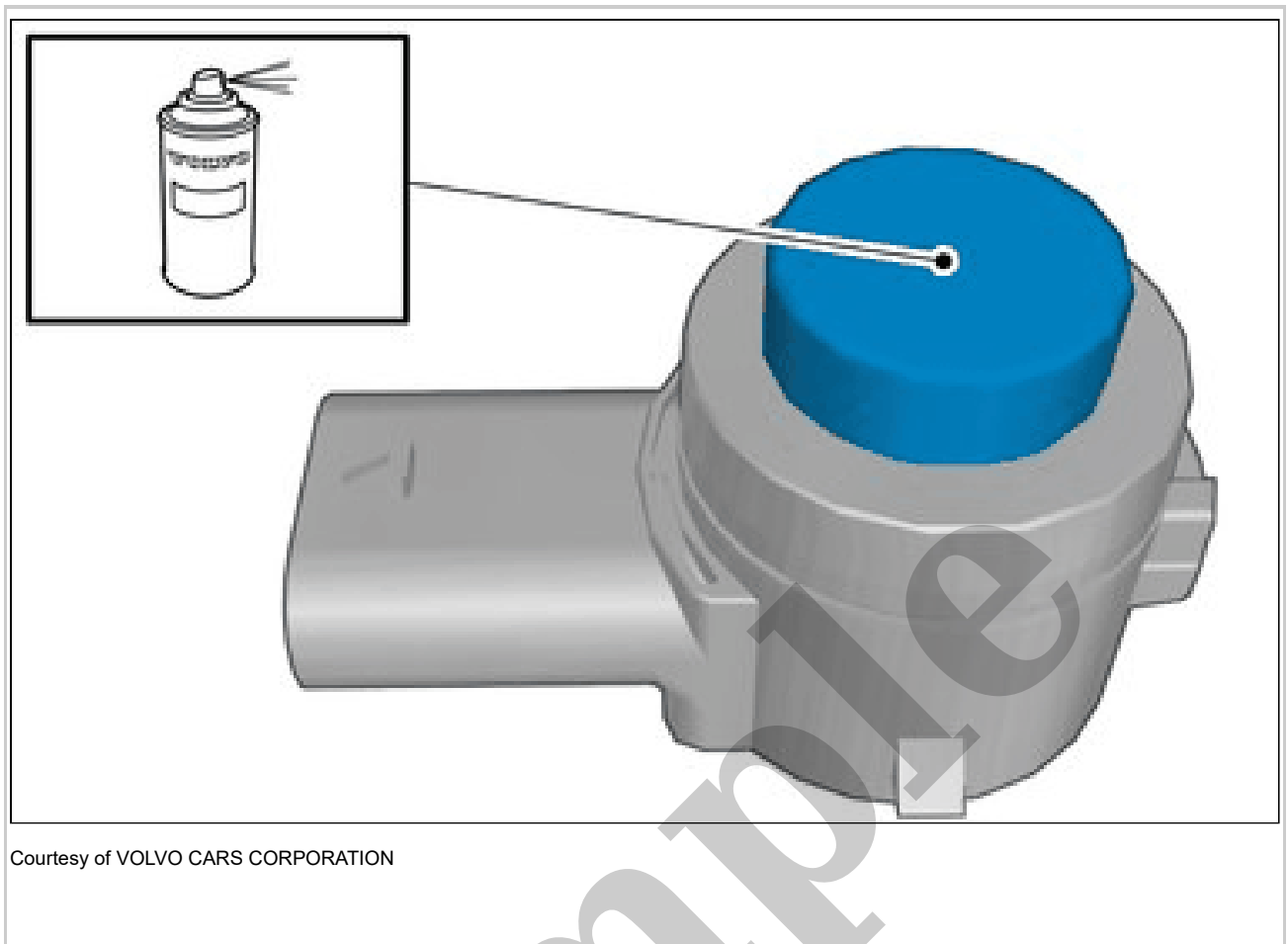

#### **INSTALLATION**

**NOTE:** *The following steps are only necessary when installing a new component.*



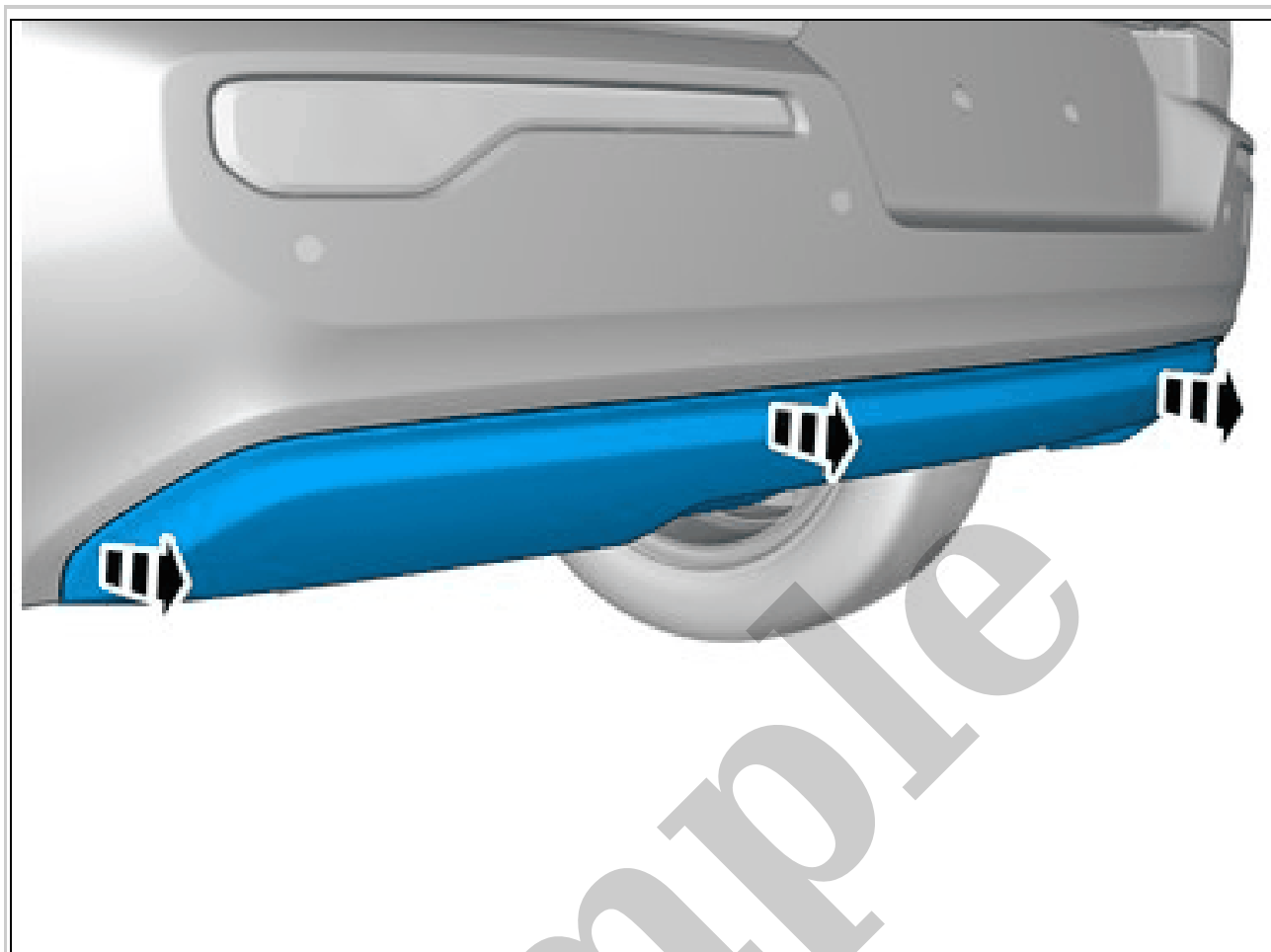

**CAUTION:** *Protect connector surfaces against paint spray.*

**NOTE:** *Paint the sensors the same color code as the vehicle.*

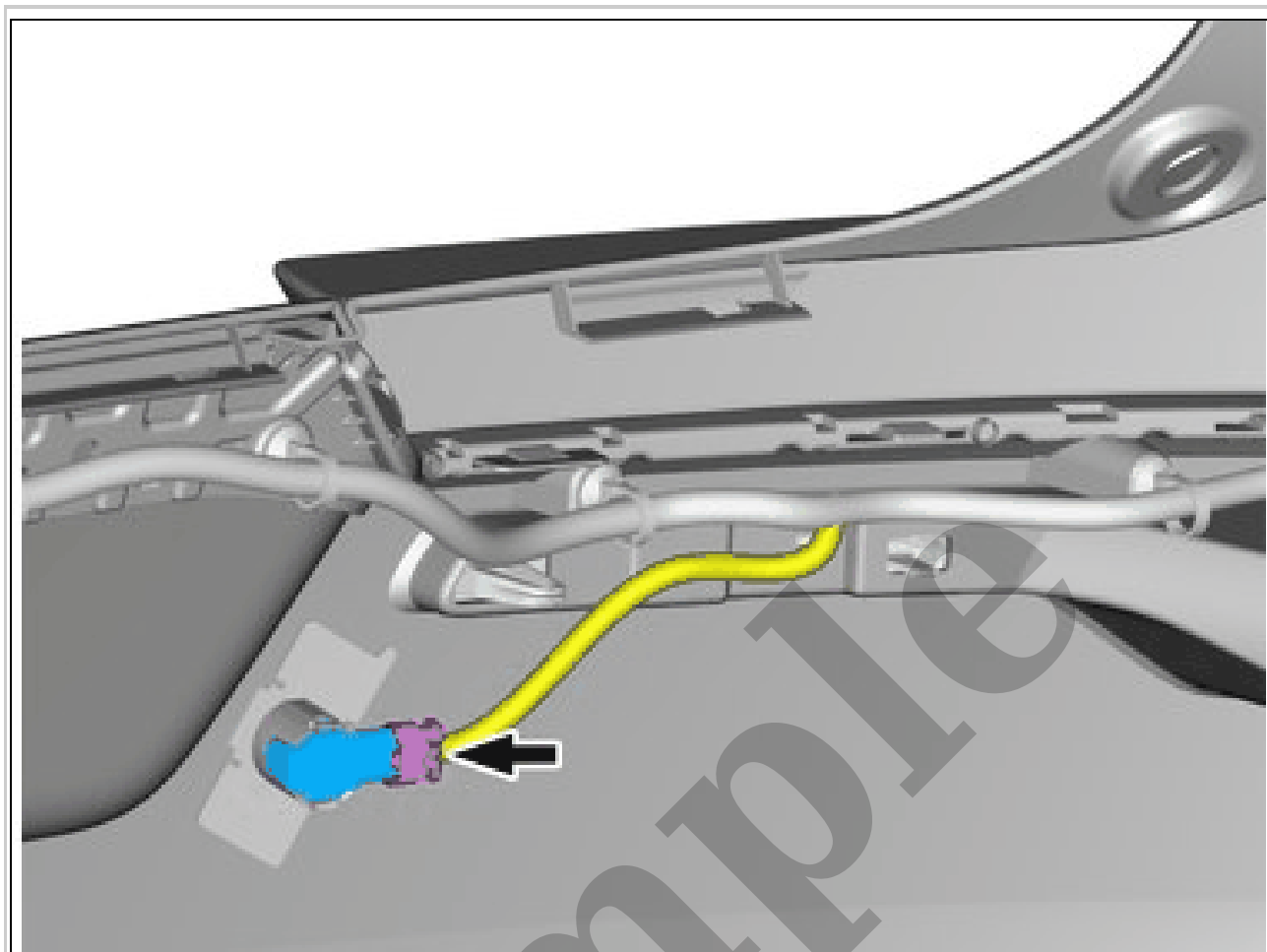
**Use:** Volvo Original Touch-up paint,  
Use base coat only.

**Use:** Varnish 2-component, 31335447  
Also see the instructions on the container.



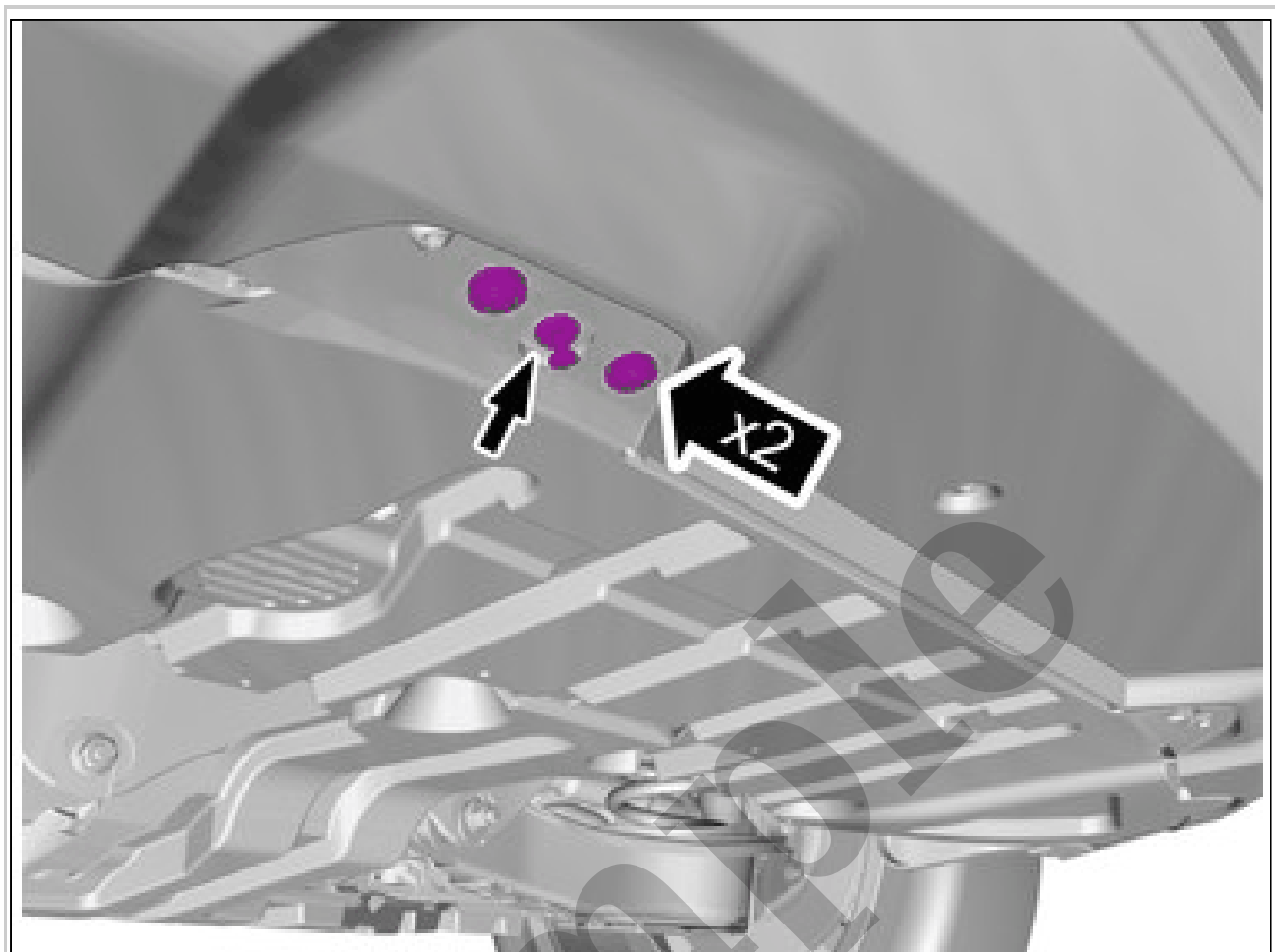

Remove the marked part.



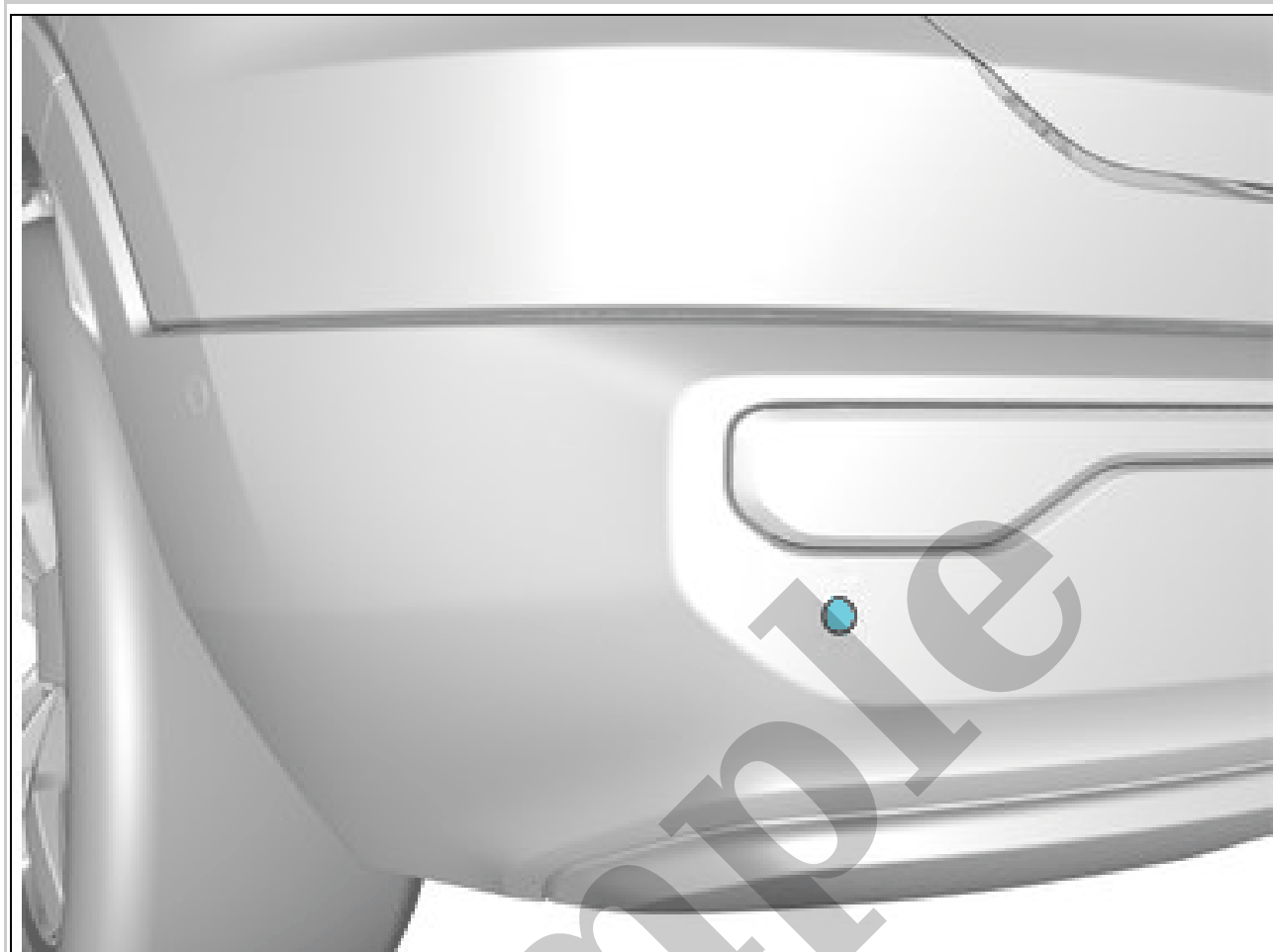

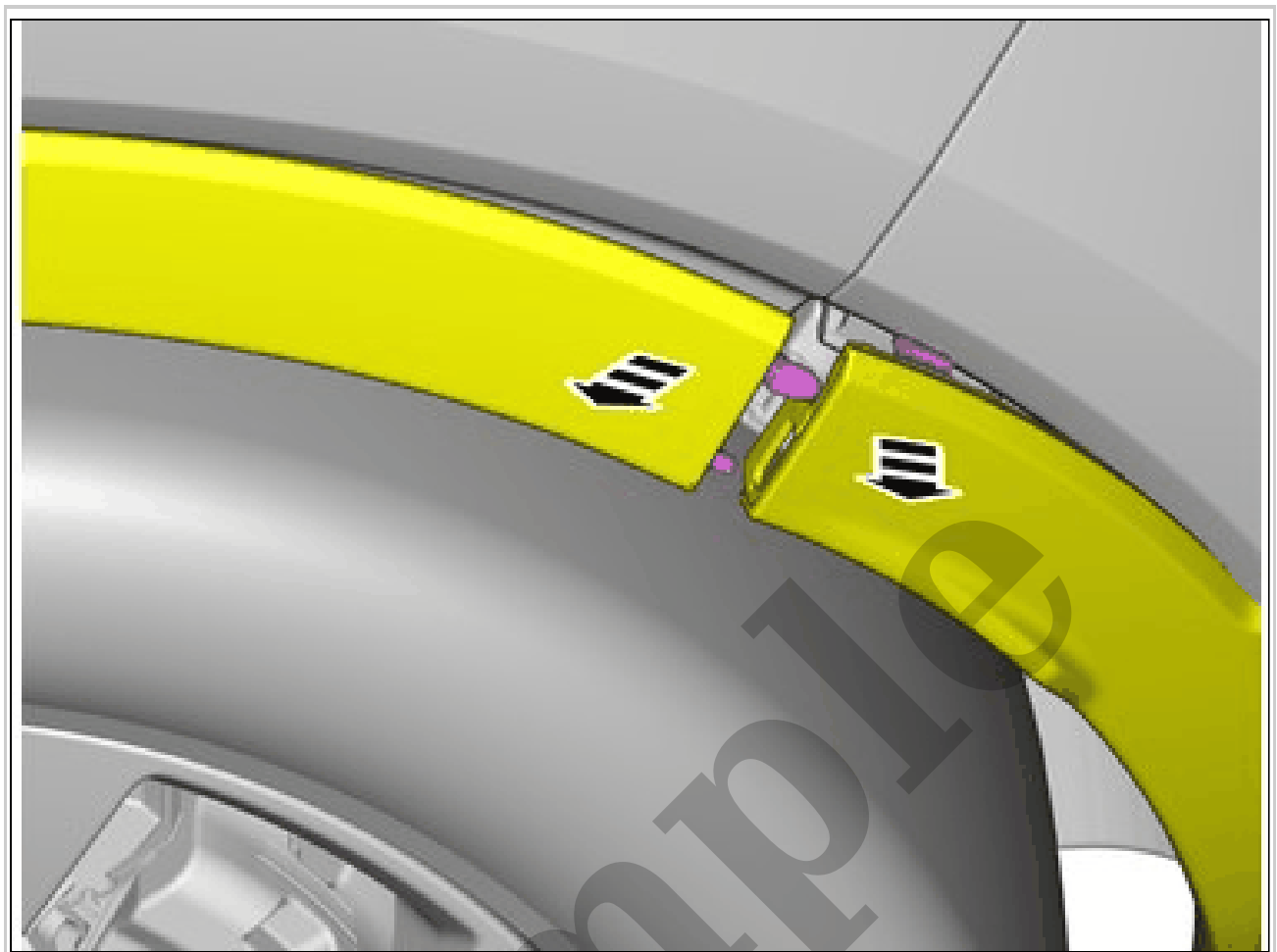
Remove the clip.

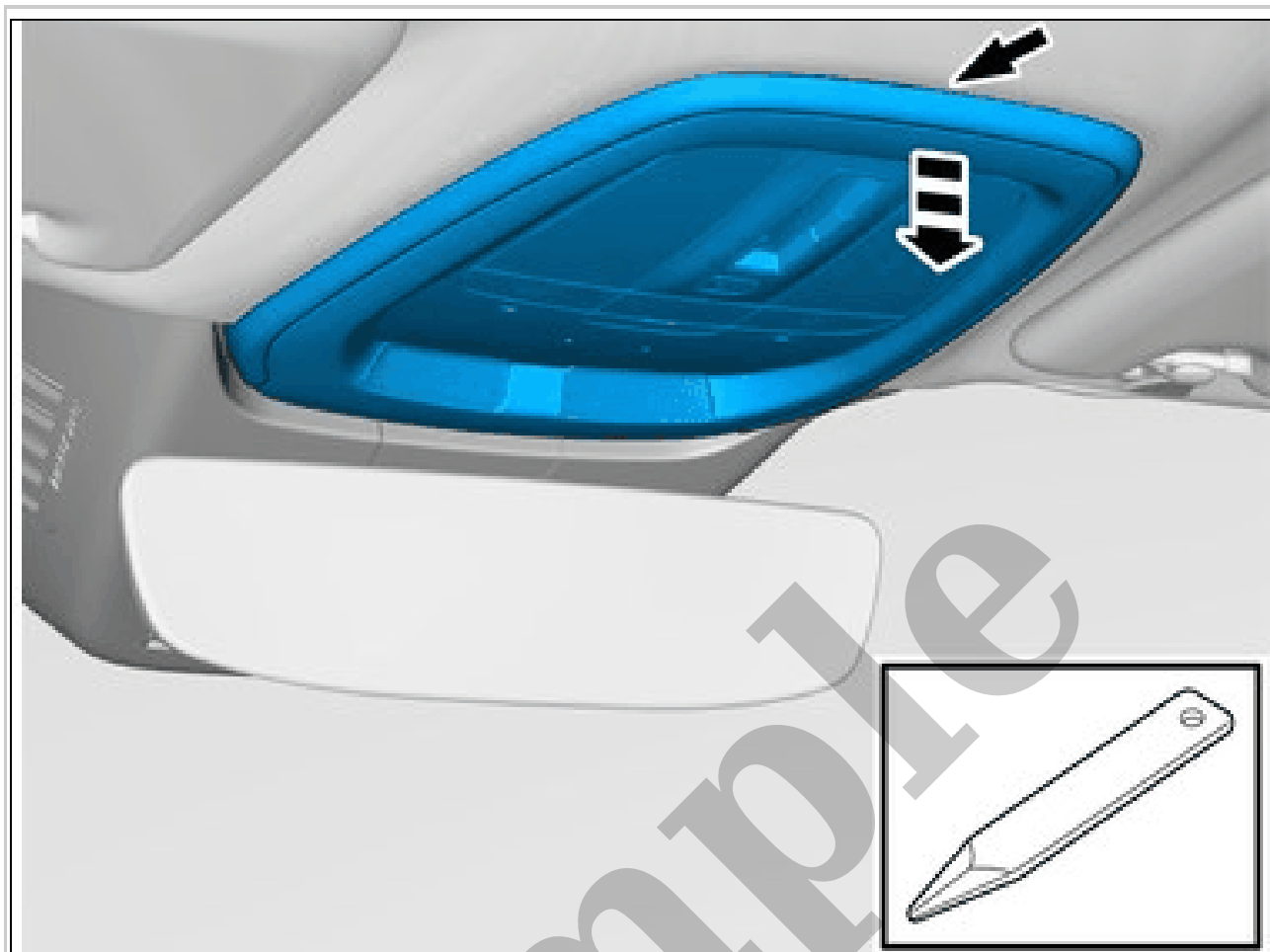
**NOTE:** *Orientation view*
