Conditions for Running the DTC

Battery voltage must be between 9-16 V.

Conditions for Setting the DTC

B154A39

An internal malfunction has been detected by the outside rearview mirror switch while commanding the driver outside rearview mirror UP, DOWN, LEFT or RIGHT.

B154B39

An internal malfunction has been detected by the passenger window switch while commanding the passenger outside rearview mirror UP, DOWN, LEFT or RIGHT.

Action Taken When the DTC Sets

The affected outside rearview mirror will be inoperative.

Conditions for Clearing the DTC

B154A39

The driver outside rearview mirror must be replaced before the DTC can be cleared.

B154B39

The passenger outside rearview mirror must be replaced before the DTC can be cleared.





Preliminary Procedures

- Remove the windshield washer solvent container. Refer to Windshield Washer Solvent Container Replacement.
- 2. Disconnect the rear window washer solvent hose connection from the underbody washer hose.



- The air bag indicator turns ON.
- The adaptive cruise control is inhibited.
- The traction/stability control indicator turns ON.
- The electronic brake control module disables the hill hold and the trailer sway control for the duration of the ignition cycle.

Conditions for Clearing the DTC

- A current DTC clears when the diagnostic runs and passes.
- The history DTC will clear after 40 consecutive fault-free ignition cycles have occurred.



Circuit/System Verification

1. Verify DTC B101D is not set current or history in the K36 Inflatable Restraint Sensing and Diagnostic Module.




5. Release the front wheel speed sensor harness electrical connector (1) from the brake hose bracket.

6. Release the front wheel speed sensor harness retainers (2).



Remove the brake pedal return spring (1) from the brake pedal.

Install the lower electronic parking brake control module bracket bolt (1) and tighten to **9 N·m (80 lb in)** .
