
- 45. 1. Release the clamp and remove the coolant hose.


- 47. 1. Reposition the wiring protective cover.

 - 5. Remove the fasteners and the generator.




49. Remove and discard the thermostat housing gaskets.



51. Detach the transmission wiring harness retainer.




53. Remove the bolt and the accessory drive belt tensioner.


54. Remove bolts and position the generator to access the electrical connections.




56. **NOTICE**

Only use hand tools when loosening the engine mount through bolts or damage to the engine mount-to-cylinder block bracket can occur.


Remove and discard the LH (left-hand) engine mount through bolt.




59. Remove the upper bellhousing bolts.

62. **NOTICE**


Only use hand tools when removing or installing the engine mount-to-frame bolts or damage to the engine mount-to-frame nut plate can occur.
