




Remove the screw.


Disconnect the connector. Fold marked part aside.

Torque: Cross member, to Body, 10Nm



CAUTION: Make sure that the wiring harness does not catch.


NOTE: This step requires the aid of another technician.


Install the screws. **Torque:** M8, 24Nm

Disconnect the connector.



Loosen the clip.


Remove the cable harness clips.
