





17. **NOTE**


Make sure to cover any open ports to prevent debris from entering the system.

Remove the nut and disconnect the A/C (air conditioning) coupling.

Torque: 159 lb.in (18 Nm)




19. Disconnect the CAC (charge air cooler) electrical connector and wire retainer.



20. Remove the nuts, the wiring ground terminal and detach the wiring harness retainer.



- 22. Disconnect the LH (left-hand) body wiring harness connectors.
 - Detach the wiring retainer and position aside.



Torque: 71 lb.in (8 Nm)


29. **NOTE**

Place the transmission selector lever in Neutral after removing cable.

• Remove the bolt.

Torque: 177 lb.in (20 Nm)

• Pull out and position aside the selector lever cable.





Place the transmission selector lever in Neutral after removing cable.

Install the shift bracket bolt.

32. Disconnect hose from evaporative emission canister to body and position aside.

33. WARNING


Do not reuse steering column shaft bolts. This may result in fastener failure and steering column shaft detachment or loss of steering control. Failure to follow this instruction may result in serious injury to vehicle occupant(s).

Separate the steering column lower shaft.


• Remove and discard the steering column shaft bolt.

Torque: 41 lb.ft (55 Nm)

• Separate the steering column lower shaft coupler from the steering column upper shaft.




36. Disconnect the engine vent hose.
