




• If the thermistor characteristic is not as shown in the graph, replace the rear seat cushion pad. (See REAR SEAT CUSHION TRIM REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)

Seat back side


- 1. Switch the ignition to off.
- 2. Disconnect the negative battery terminal and wait for 1 min or more. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)
- 3. Disconnect the right-side seat warmer unit connector.
- 4. Inspect for continuity between the right-side seat warmer unit connector (short cord) terminal A and B.



— If not as specified, replace the rear seat back pad. (See REAR SEAT BACK TRIM REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)



4. Remove the bolts and remove the front seat.



5.Install in the reverse order of removal.

POWER SEAT SWITCH INSPECTION


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Warning

- Handling a side air bag improperly can accidentally operate (deploy) the air bag, which may seriously injure you. Read the service warnings/cautions in the Workshop Manual before handling the front seat (side air bag integrated). - 1.Switch the ignition OFF (LOCK).
- 2.Disconnect the negative battery terminal and wait for 1 min or more. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION.)
- 3.Remove the front seat side cover. (See FRONT SEAT SIDE COVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 4.Remove the power seat switch. (See POWER SEAT SWITCH REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 5. Verify that the continuity between the power seat switch terminals is as indicated in the table.
 - If not as indicated in the table, replace the power seat switch. (See POWER SEAT SWITCH REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)

5. Apply battery positive voltage to the lumber support motor terminals and inspect the front seat operation.



• If not as specified, replace the front seat back frame. (See FRONT SEAT BACK FRAME REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)



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Rear Seat Back Latch (LH,RH)


- 1.Disconnect the negative battery terminal. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)
- 2. Remove the following parts.

When removing the rear seat back latch (LH)

- 1. Trunk board (See TRUNK BOARD REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 2. Sub-trunk (See SUB-TRUNK REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 3. Rear seat cushion. (See REAR SEAT CUSHION REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 4. Rear center seat belt lower anchor installation bolt (See REAR CENTER SEAT BELT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 5. Head restraint
- 6. Remote handle cable (With remote handle lever) (See REMOTE HANDLE LEVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 7. Rear seat warmer control unit connector (With rear seat warmer system)
- 8. Rear seat back (See REAR SEAT BACK REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 9. Rear seat back frame (See REAR SEAT BACK FRAME REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)

When removing the rear seat back latch (RH)

- 1. Trunk board (See TRUNK BOARD REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 2. Sub-trunk (See SUB-TRUNK REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 3. Rear center seat belt lower anchor installation bolt (See REAR CENTER SEAT BELT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 4. Head restraint
- 5. Remote handle cable (With remote handle lever) (See REMOTE HANDLE LEVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 6. Rear seat warmer control unit connector (With rear seat warmer system)
- 7. Rear seat back (See REAR SEAT BACK REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 8. Rear seat back frame (See REAR SEAT BACK FRAME REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 3. Remove the screws.



4.Disengage the tabs and remove the rear seat back latch cover.

7.Install in the reverse order of removal.






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- 1.Perform the front door glass preparation. (See FRONT DOOR GLASS REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 2.Disconnect the negative battery terminal. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)
- 3. Remove the following parts:
 - (1)Front door trim (See FRONT DOOR TRIM REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (2)Front door speaker (See FRONT DOOR SPEAKER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (3)Front door glass (See FRONT DOOR GLASS REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (4)Front door module panel (See FRONT DOOR MODULE PANEL REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (5)Front door key cylinder (See FRONT DOOR KEY CYLINDER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (6)Front inner handle (See FRONT DOOR LATCH AND LOCK ACTUATOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (7)Front door latch and lock actuator (See FRONT DOOR LATCH AND LOCK ACTUATOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 4. Verify that the continuity is as indicated in the table.




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
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• If not as indicated in the table, replace the front door latch and lock actuator.

8.Tilt the rear door latch and lock actuator in the direction of arrow (1) shown in the figure and lift it in the direction of arrow (2) to detach the hook of the rear door latch and lock actuator.



- 9. Remove the rear door latch and lock actuator.
- 10.Install in the reverse order of removal.
