
3. Assemble in the reverse order of disassembly.

Note

- When replacing the dashboard, remove the following parts:
 - 1. Center speaker grille (See SPEAKER GRILLE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 2. Front center speaker (With Bose ®) (See FRONT CENTER SPEAKER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 3. Global positioning system (GPS) antenna (See GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS) ANTENNA **REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)**
 - 4. Keyless antenna (See KEYLESS ANTENNA REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 5. Side ventilator grille (See VENTILATOR GRILLE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 6. Solar radiation sensor (See SOLAR RADIATION SENSOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION [FULL-AUTO AIR CONDITIONER].)
 - 7. Ambient temperature sensor (See AMBIENT TEMPERATURE SENSOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION [FULL-AUTO AIR CONDITIONER].) (See AMBIENT TEMPERATURE SENSOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION [MANUAL AIR CONDITIONER].)

Dashboard Wiring Harness Removal Note

1.The shape of the wiring harness clips at the positions shown in the figure cannot be visually verified. Refer to wiring harness clips A and B shown in the figure when removing the dashboard wiring harness.


COLUMN COVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION

Upper Column Cover

- 1.Lower the steering wheel to the bottommost position.
- 2.Press the shaded areas shown in the figure, lift the upper column cover in the direction of the arrows, and detach the pins, tabs, and guides from the lower column cover.

3. While pressing the tabs of meter hood No.1 in the direction of arrow (1) shown in the figure, press them up in the direction of arrow (2) and detach the tabs from the upper column cover.

Meter Hood No.1

- 1.Disconnect the negative battery terminal. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)
- 2.Remove the following parts:
 - (1)Lower decoration panel (See DECORATION PANEL REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (2)Upper decoration panel (See DECORATION PANEL REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (3)Driver-side decoration panel (See DECORATION PANEL REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - (4)Upper column cover (See COLUMN COVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)


3. Hold the shaded areas shown in the figure, pull meter hood No.1 in the order of arrows (1) and (2), and remove it while detaching clips A and B.

SWITCH PANEL REMOVAL/INSTALLATION

- 1.Disconnect the negative battery terminal. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)
- 2.Remove the console side panel. (See CONSOLE SIDE PANEL REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 3.Using a remover tool, move the switch panel in the order of arrows (1), (2), (3), and (4) shown in the figure, detach the clips, and remove the switch panel.




- 4. Disconnect the commander switch connector.
- 5.Disconnect the electric parking brake switch connector.


- When replacing the switch panel, remove the electric parking brake switch. (See ELECTRIC PARKING BRAKE SWITCH REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- When replacing the switch panel, remove the commander switch. (See COMMANDER SWITCH REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 6.Install in the reverse order of removal.




7.Pull the rear combination light in the direction of arrow (1) shown in the figure and pull out the rear combination light from the body.




8. Turn the socket counterclockwise and remove it in the direction of arrow (1) shown in the figure.






5. Move the remover tool in the direction of arrow (1) shown in the figure, pull out the lens from the pin.



6.Remove the lens.

7. Widen the rear map light spring in the direction of the arrows (1) shown in the figure to detach the spring from the rear map light bulb.



Caution

• If there is oil or dirt on the surface of the light bulb, excessive heat will build up and the life of the light bulb will be shortened. If the light bulb glass area is touched, wipe off any dirt using a soft cloth dampened with detergent diluted in water (approx. 5%).




1.Disconnect the negative battery terminal. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)

Caution

- When inserting the remover tool in the gap between the front map light and the lens, the remover tool could interfere with the front map light and scratch or damage it. When removing the lens from the front map light, apply protective tape to the front map light.
- 2.To prevent scratches or damage, affix protective tape to the position shown in the figure.



3. Press the lens to assure a space for inserting the remover tool.




4.Insert the remover tool into the gap between the front map light and the lens shown in the figure.


REAR COMBINATION LIGHT SHORT-CORD INSPECTION

- 1.Disconnect the negative battery terminal. (See NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL DISCONNECTION/CONNECTION.)
- 2.Remove the following parts.
 - 1. Rear combination light (See REAR COMBINATION LIGHT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 2. Trunk board (See TRUNK BOARD REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 3. Bass-box (with Bose®)(See BASS-BOX REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 4. Sub-trunk (See SUB-TRUNK REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 5. Trunk end trim (See TRUNK END TRIM REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
 - 6. Rear scuff plate (See REAR SCUFF PLATE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 3. Partially peel back the trunk side trim. (See TRUNK SIDE TRIM REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 4.Remove the rear combination light short-cord. (See REAR COMBINATION LIGHT SHORT-CORD REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
- 5. Verify that the continuity between the rear combination light short-cord terminals is as indicated in the table.





• If not as indicated in the table, replace the rear turn light bulb or the rear combination light short-cord. (See REAR TURN LIGHT BULB REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.) (See REAR COMBINATION LIGHT SHORT-CORD REMOVAL/INSTALLATION.)
